**DUSTSTORM/THUNDER-RAIN EXPECTED IN ALL THE DISTRICTS OF
UPPER SINDH FROM 13TH TO 16TH JUNE**

Pakistan Meteorological Department has predicted that moist currents are penetrating in upper parts of the country and a westerly wave is also likely to approach upper parts on **13th June**. Under the influence of these weather system:

Dust-storm/thunder-rain is expected in all the districts of upper Sindh from **13th June to 16th June**.

Possible Impacts and advice:

- Dust-storm/thunder-rain may damage loose structures like electric poles, trees, vehicles and solar panels etc.
- Farmers are advised to manage their crop activities keeping in view the weather conditions.

Keeping in view above, it is requested that concerned Deputy Commissioners / Chairman DDMA's and other relevant authorities/ stakeholders may take all necessary mitigation measures.

PRECAUTIONS FOR GENERAL PUBLIC:

- Monitor the weather alerts through print media, electronic media, & social media.
- Stay indoor unless absolutely necessary. Keep doors and windows shut and avoid sitting near windows as rain is often accompanied by strong winds.
- Maintain a distance from power lines or electrical wires. If you notice any loose electric wires in your area, alert the authorities immediately.
- Avoid touching electrical switches or outlets while it is raining. Do not try using electrical sockets or outlets outdoors while it is raining.
- Avoid underpasses, drainage ditches, low-lying areas and areas where water collects.
- Check on family members who are especially at risk from weather hazards: young children, older adults, and the chronically ill.
- Avoid parking near walls, weak structures, or under trees; ensure car windows and windscreens are properly secured, and solar panels are firmly fixed to prevent damage.

Press Release:

Duststorm/rain-thundershower predicted in upper/central parts from 13th to 16th June with occasional gaps

Severe Heatwave conditions are likely to subside during the period.

Met Office predicted that moist currents are penetrating in upper parts of the country and a westerly wave is also likely to approach upper parts on 13th June. Under the influence of these weather system:

- Duststorm/Rain-thundershower (with isolated hailstorm) are expected in Kashmir, Gilgit Baltistan, Murree, Galliyat, Chitral, Dir, Swat, Malakand, Mansehra, Battagram, Shangla, Kohistan and Abbottabad from 13th to 16th June with occasional gaps.
- Duststorm/Rain-thundershower (with isolated hailstorm) are also expected in Islamabad, Rawalpindi, Attock, Chakwal, Jhelum, Mianwali, Sargodha, Hafizabad, Mandi Bahauddin, Gujranwala, Gujrat, Sialkot, Narowal, Lahore, Faisalabad, Jhang, Toba Tek Singh, Haripur, Peshawar, Mardan, Swabi, Nowshera, Charsadda, Bajaur, Mohmand, Khyber, Orakzai, Kurram, Kohat, Bannu, Karak ,D.I. Khan, Waziristan, Zhob, Barkhan and Musakhel on 13th and 16th June with occasional gaps. Duststorm/thunder-rain is also expected in all the districts of southern Punjab and upper Sindh during the period.

Possible Impacts and advice:

- Windstorm/dust-thunderstorm/hailstorm/lightning may damage loose structures like electric poles, trees, vehicles and solar panels etc in upper/central parts including Islamabad.
- Prevailing severe heatwave conditions are likely to subside during the forecast period.
- Farmers are advised to manage their crop activities keeping in view the weather conditions.
- General Public, Travelers & Tourists are advised to take precautionary measures during the weather activity.

Note: All concerned authorities are advised to remain “ALERT” and take necessary measures to avoid any untoward situation.

13 سے 16 جون کے دوران بالائی/وسطی علاقوں میں وقفے وقفے سے آندھی/جھکڑ/گرج چمک کے ساتھ بارش کی پیش گوئی اس دوران شدید گرمی کی لہر میں کمی کا امکان

- مکمل موسمیات کے مطابق مرطوب ہوائیں ملک کے بالائی علاقوں میں داخل ہو رہی ہیں اور مغربی ہواؤں کا سلسلہ بھی 13 جون سے ملک کے بالائی علاقوں پر اثر انداز ہونے کا امکان ہے۔ جس کے باعث:
- **13 سے 16 جون کے دوران:** کشمیر، گلگت بلتستان، مری، گلیات، چترال، دیر، سوات، مالاکنڈ، مانسہرہ، بنگرام، شانگلہ، کوہستان اور ایبٹ آباد میں آندھی/جھکڑ اور گرج چمک کے ساتھ وقفے وقفے سے بارش کا امکان۔ اس دوران چند مقامات پر ژالہ باری کی بھی توقع۔
 - **13 سے 16 جون کے دوران:** اسلام آباد، راولپنڈی، انک، چکوال، جہلم، میانوالی، سرگودھا، حافظ آباد، منڈی بہاؤالدین، گوجرانوالہ، گجرات، سیالکوٹ، نارووال، لاہور، فیصل آباد، جھنگ، ٹوبہ ٹیک سنگھ، ہری پور، پشاور، مردان، صوابی، نوشہرہ، چارسدہ، باجوڑ، مہمند، خیبر، اورکزئی، کرم، کوہاٹ، بنوں، کرک، ڈی آئی خان، وزیرستان، ثوب، بارکھان اور موسیٰ خیل میں آندھی/جھکڑ اور گرج چمک کے ساتھ وقفے وقفے سے بارش اور چند مقامات پر ژالہ باری کی بھی توقع۔ اس دوران جنوبی پنجاب اور بالائی سندھ کے تمام اضلاع میں آندھی/جھکڑ اور گرج چمک کے ساتھ بارش کا بھی امکان۔

مکمل اثرات اور احتیاطی تدابیر:

- اسلام آباد سمیت بالائی/وسطی حصوں میں آندھی/جھکڑ/ژالہ باری/گرج چمک اور تیز/موسلا دھار بارش کے باعث کمزور انفراسٹرکچر (بجلی کے کھمبے، درخت، گاڑیوں، سولر پینل وغیرہ) کو نقصان کا اندیشہ۔
- اس دوران موجودہ شدید گرمی کی لہر میں کمی کا امکان۔
- کاشت کار حضرات اپنی فصلوں کے معاملات موسمی حالات کے مطابق ترتیب دیں۔
- عوام الناس مسافروں اور سیاحوں کو خراب موسم کے دوران احتیاطی تدابیر اختیار کرنے کا مشورہ۔
- **نوٹ:** تمام متعلقہ اداروں کو اس دوران ”ارٹ“ رہنے اور کسی ناخوشگوار واقعہ سے بچنے کے لیے تمام ضروری اقدامات کرنے کی ہدایت کی جاتی ہے۔
