


Situation Report for heatwave 2025

MONSOON RAINS PREDICTED IN THE COUNTRY


- --Pakistan Meteorological Department has informed that monsoon currents are penetrating upper and central parts of the country and likely to become more intensified in next couple of days. A westerly wave is moving toward the upper parts of the country and is likely to become more active on June 26.
- --Duststorm-Thunderstorm / rain is expected in Tharparker, Umerkot, Mirpurkhas, Badin, and Dadu districts on 26th June.
- --Duststorm-Thundershower / rain likely in Sukkur, Larkano, Jacobabad, Khairpur, Ghotki, Kashmore, Dadu, Naushahro Feroze, Shaheed Benazirabad, Hyderabad, Tharparker, Mirpurkhas, Sanghar, Jamshoro, Tando Allahyar, Tando Muhammad Khan, Thatta, Badin , and Karachi division on 27th June with occasional gaps.
- --Keep doors and windows shut and avoid sitting near windows as rain is often accompanied by strong winds.
- --Maintain a distance from power lines or electrical wires. If you notice any loose electric wires in your area, alert the authorities immediately.
- --Start Network (READY Pakistan) and its partner organizations are actively responding to the ongoing heatwaves across various districts of Sindh, including Jacobabad, through Heatwave Anticipatory Action initiatives. These efforts include preparedness support by establishing heat stabilization centers at DHQ Jacobabad, THQ Garhi Khairo and RHC Mirpur Burriro. The response also involves the capacity building of 100 health-care providers, frontline workers, and paramedics on heatstroke case management. Additionally, over 200 volunteers have been trained on climate change, the impacts of heatwaves, community-level preventive measures, and first aid for heatstroke. Public awareness has been further enhanced through the publication and distribution of IEC materials, along with awareness campaigns and early warnings disseminated via social media and other communication platforms.
- --15 Humanitarian Partners conducted awareness sessions on heatwave impacts, distr--ibuted Information, Education & Communication (IECC) material, displayed Banners and awareness raising through print, electronic, social and local media-content approved by PDMA
