Subject: **DUST-THUNDERSTORM/RAIN PREDICTED IN UPPER AND CENTRAL
PARTS FROM 02ND (NIGHT) TO 04TH MAY**

Pakistan Meteorological Department has informed that a fresh westerly wave is likely to approach northwestern parts of the country on **02nd (evening) May** and likely to persist in upper parts till **05th May (Morning)**. Under its influence:

- Dust thunderstorm is expected in upper Sindh on **02nd & 03rd May**.

Possible Impacts and advices:

- Windstorm/ hailstorm and lightning may damage weak structures (electric poles, bill boards, solar panels etc) during the forecast period.
- Prevailing very hot weather condition over the plain areas of the country is likely to subside during the forecast period.
- Farmers are advised to manage their crops according to the prevailing weather conditions.

2. Keeping in view above, it is requested that all concerned Deputy Commissioners / Chairman DDMA's and other relevant authorities/ stakeholders may take all necessary mitigation measures.

Note: All concerned authorities are advised to remain "Vigilant" and take necessary measures to avoid any untoward Situation during the forecast period.

Dust-thunderstorm/rain predicted in upper and central parts from 02nd (night) to 04th May

Met office predicted that a fresh westerly wave is likely to approach northwestern parts of the country on 02nd (evening) May and likely to persist in upper parts till 05th May (Morning). Under the influence of this weather system:

- **Kyber Pakhtunkhwa:** Dust-thunderstorm/rain with isolated heavy falls/hailstorm is expected in Chitral, Dir, Swat, Kalam, Shangla, Buner, Kohistan, Malakand, Battagram, Mansehra, Abbottabad, Balakot, Haripur, Mardan, Nowshera, Peshawar, Bajaur, Mohmand, Orakzai, Khyber, Swabi, Charsadda, Kohat, Kurram, Hangu, Karak, Bannu, Lakki Marwat, Tank, Dera Ismail Khan and Waziristan from 02nd (evening) to 04th May with occasional gaps.
- **Punjab/Islamabad:** Dust-thunderstorm/rain with isolated hailstorm is expected in Murree, Galiyat, Islamabad/Rawalpindi, Attock, Chakwal, Jhelum, Khushab, Sargodha, Mianwali, Bhakkar, Faisalabad, Sahiwal, Jhang, Lahore, Gujranwala, Sialkot, Narowal from 02nd (evening) to 04th May (night) with occasional gaps. While Rain-windstorm/thunderstorm with isolated hailstorm may occur in Dera Ghazi Khan, Rajanpur, Layyah, Khushab, Noorpurthal, Multan and Khanewal on 03rd & 04th May.
- **Gilgit Baltistan:** Rain-wind/thunderstorm is expected in (Diamir, Astore, Ghizer, Skardu, Hunza, Gilgit, Guaniche, Shigar) from 02nd (night) to 05th May with occasional gaps.
- **Kashmir:** Rain-wind/thunderstorm with isolated heavy falls/hailstorm is expected in Kashmir (Neelum valley, Muzaffarabad, Poonch, Hattian, Bagh, Haveli, Sudhanoti, Kotli, Bhimber, Mirpur) from 02nd (night) to 05th May with occasional gaps.
- **Balochistan:** Windstorm/thunderstorm is expected in Quetta, Ziarat, Chaman, Qilla Abdullah, Qilla Saifullah, Kohlu, Zhob, Barkhan and Loralai from 02nd to 04th May with occasional gaps.
- **Sindh:** Dust thunderstorm is expected in upper Sindh on 02nd & 03rd May.

Possible Impacts and advises:

- Windstorm/ hailstorm and lightning may damage weak structures (electric poles, bill boards, solar panels etc.) during the forecast period.
- Landslides may occur in vulnerable areas of upper Khyber Pakhtunkhwa, Gilgit-Baltistan and Kashmir on 03rd and 04th May.
- Hailstorm/windstorm may damage standing crops in Khyber-Pakhtunkhwa and upper Punjab. Farmers are advised to manage their crops according to the prevailing weather conditions.
- Prevailing very hot weather condition over the plain areas of the country is likely to subside during the forecast period.
- Tourists and travelers are advised to remain extra cautious and avoid unnecessary travelling during the forecast period.

Note: All concerned authorities are advised to remain “Vigilant” and take necessary measures to avoid any untoward Situation during the forecast period.

02(رات) سے 04 مئی کے دوران ملک کے بالائی/وسطی علاقوں میں آندھی اور گرج چمک کے ساتھ بارش کی پیش گوئی

حکومت موسمیات کی پیش گوئی کے مطابق ایک مغربی ہواؤں کا سلسلہ 02 مئی کو ملک کے شمال مغربی علاقوں میں داخل ہونے کا امکان ہے اور یہ 05 مئی تک بالائی علاقوں میں برقرار رہنے کی توقع ہے۔ اس موسمی نظام کے زیر اثر:

- خیبر پختونخواہ: 02(شام) سے 04 مئی کے دوران چترال، دیر، سوات، کالام، شانگلہ، بونیر، کوہستان، ملاکنڈ، بنگرام، مانسہرہ، لیٹ آباد، بالا کوٹ، ہری پور، مردان، نوشہرہ، پشاور، باجوڑ، مہمند، اورکزئی، خیبر، صوابی، چارسدہ، کوہاٹ، کرم، ہنگو، کرک، بنوں، کلی مروت، ٹانک، ڈیرہ اسماعیل خان اور وزیرستان میں وقفے وقفے سے آندھی اور گرج چمک کے ساتھ بارش (چند مقامات پر موسلا دھار بارش/ثرالہ باری) کا امکان ہے۔
 - پنجاب/اسلام آباد: 02(شام) سے 04 مئی (رات) کے دوران مری، گلیات، اسلام آباد/راولپنڈی، انک، چکوال، جہلم، خوشاب، سرگودھا، میانوالی، بھکر، فیصل آباد، ساہیوال، جھنگ، لاہور، گوجرانوالہ، سیالکوٹ اور نارووال میں وقفے وقفے سے آندھی اور گرج چمک کے ساتھ بارش جبکہ چند مقامات پر ثرالہ باری کا امکان۔ جبکہ 03 اور 04 مئی کے دوران ڈیرہ غازی خان، راجن پور، لیہ، خوشاب، نور پور، تھل، ملتان اور خانیوال میں آندھی/گرج چمک بھی متوقع ہے۔
 - گلگت بلتستان: 02(رات) سے 05 مئی کے دوران دیامر، استور، غدر، اسکردو، ہنزہ، گلگت، گانچے اور شگر میں وقفے وقفے سے تیز ہواؤں اور گرج چمک کے ساتھ بارش کا امکان ہے۔
 - کشمیر: 02(رات) سے 05 مئی کے دوران وادی نیلم، مظفر آباد، پونچھ، ہٹیاں، بان، حویلی، سدھوتی، کوٹلی، بھمبر اور میر پور میں وقفے وقفے سے تیز ہواؤں/آندھی اور گرج چمک کے ساتھ بارش (چند مقامات پر ثرالہ باری/موسلا دھار بارش) کا امکان ہے۔
 - بلوچستان: 02 اور 04 مئی کے دوران: کونہ، زیارت، چمن، قلعہ عبداللہ، قلعہ سیف اللہ، کولہو، ژوب، بارکھان اور لورائی میں وقفے وقفے سے تیز/گرد آلود ہوائیں چلنے اور گرج چمک کا امکان ہے۔
 - سندھ: 02 اور 03 مئی کے دوران: بالائی سندھ میں آندھی/تیز ہوائیں چلنے اور گرج چمک کا امکان ہے۔
- مکمل اثرات اور احتیاطی تدابیر:
- اس دوران تیز ہواؤں، ثرالہ باری اور آسمانی ٹکلی کرنے کے باعث کمزور ڈھانچوں (پکلی کے کھمبے، بل بورڈز، سولر پینلز وغیرہ) کو نقصان پہنچنے کا خدشہ ہے۔
 - 03 اور 04 مئی کے روز گلگت بلتستان، کشمیر اور بالائی خیبر پختونخوا کے پہاڑی علاقوں میں لینڈ سلائیڈنگ کا خطرہ۔
 - ثرالہ باری اور تیز ہواؤں/آندھی کے باعث بالائی پنجاب اور خیبر پختونخوا میں کھڑی فصلوں کو نقصان پہنچنے کا خدشہ ہے، لہذا کاشتکار حضرات موسمی حالات کے مطابق اپنی فصلوں کی دیکھ بھال کریں۔
 - ملک کے میدانی علاقوں میں جاری شدید گرم موسم کی شدت میں کمی کا امکان ہے۔
 - اس دوران سیاحوں اور مسافروں کو محتاط رہنے اور غیر ضروری سفر سے اجتناب کی ہدایت۔
- نوٹ: تمام متعلقہ اداروں کو ”ارٹ“ رہنے اور کسی ناخوشگوار واقعہ سے بچنے کے لیے تمام ضروری اقدامات کرنے کی ہدایت کی جاتی ہے۔
