**Subject: HEATWAVE CONDITIONS PREDICTED IN THE COUNTRY DURING EID  
HOLIDAYS**

Pakistan Meteorological Department has informed that a high pressure is likely to develop in upper atmosphere on **25<sup>th</sup> May** and likely to strengthen on **26<sup>th</sup> May**. Under the influence of this system:

- **Moderate to severe heatwave conditions** are likely to develop over the country from **25<sup>th</sup> to 31<sup>st</sup> May**.
- Maximum temperature is likely to remain **04 – 06 °C above normal** and may rise to **(47 - 50) °C** in the districts of Sukkur, Shikarpur, Kambar Shahdadkot, Jacobabad, Larkano, Mohenjo Daro, Dadu, Shaheed Benazirabad, Tharparkar, Badin, Sujawal, Thatta, Hyderabad, Matiari, Tando Muhamad Khan, Umerkot, Ghotki, Khairpur, Naushahro Feroze, Mirpurkhas, Jamshoro, and Sanghar.
- Very hot weather is expected in Karachi during the forecast period and Maximum Temperature is likely to remain **(35-38) °C**.
- Night temperatures are also likely to rise during the forecast period.

**Possible Impacts & Advice:**

- **Due to heatwave condition, general public especially children, women, and senior citizens are advised to be extra cautious.**
- **Farmers are advised to manage their crop activities, keeping in view the weather conditions and take care of their livestock as well.**
- **General public is advised to avoid unnecessary exposure to direct sunlight from (1000 to 1600 PST) and remain hydrated.**
- **Electricity demand / consumption may increase during the forecast period.**
- **Judicious use of water is requested in all aspects of life.**

In view of above, the concerned Deputy Commissioner(s)/Chairmen DDMA(s), line departments and other relevant authorities are requested to take necessary precautionary measures in accordance with the Heatwave SOPs already communicated by this Authority **vide letter No. PDMA(S)/7/(78)/15/363** dated: **14-04-2026**, besides take all additional remedial measures for reducing Heatwave impacts

**Weather Advisory:**

**Heatwave Conditions Predicted in the Country during Eid Holidays**

Met office informed that a high pressure is likely to develop in upper atmosphere on 25<sup>th</sup> May and likely to strengthen on 26<sup>th</sup> May. Under the influence of this system, **moderate to severe Heatwave conditions are likely to develop over the country from 25<sup>th</sup> to 31<sup>st</sup> May.**

- Maximum temperature is likely to remain **05 – 07 °C above normal** and may rise to **(42 - 45) °C** in the districts of Peshawar, Swabi, Nowshera, Mardan, Kohat, Islamabad, Rawalpindi, Attock, Chakwal, Jhelum, Lahore, Gujrat, Gujranwala, Hafizabad, Mandi Bahauddin, Sialkot, Narowal, Okara, Kasur, Faisalabad, Muzaffarabad, Mirpur, Kotli and Bhimber.
- Maximum temperature is likely to remain **05 – 07 °C above normal** and may rise to **(38 - 40) °C** in the districts of Malakand, Hazara Division, Gilgit Baltistan, Bagh, Rawalakot, Neelum Valley, Haveli and Sudhanoti.
- Maximum temperature is likely to remain **04 – 06 °C above normal** and may rise to **(47 - 50) °C** in the districts of Sukkur, Shikarpur, Qambar Shahdadkot, Jacobabad, Larkana, Mohenjo Daro, Dadu, Shaheed Benazirabad, Tharparkar, Badin, Sujawal, Thatta, Hyderabad, Matiyari, Tando Muhammad Khan, Umerkot, Ghotki, Khairpur, Nausheroferoze, Mirpur Khas, Jamshoro, Sanghar, Sibbi, Turbat, Panjgur, Dera Ismail Khan, Bannu, Karak, Lakki Marwat, Waziristan, Dera Ghazi Khan, Multan, Khanewal, Pakpattan, Rahim Yar Khan, Rajanpur, Bahawalpur, Bahawalnagar, Bhakkar, Layyah, Kot Addu, Sargodha, Joharabad, Khushab, Mianwali, Noor Pur Thal, Jhang, Toba Tek Sing and Sahiwal.

محکمہ موسمیات کی پیش گوئی کے مطابق 25 مئی کو فضاء میں ہائی پریشر بننے کا امکان ہے جو 26 مئی تک مزید طاقتور ہو سکتا ہے۔ اس سسٹم کے زیر اثر 25 سے 31 مئی کے دوران ملک میں درمیانی سے شدید ہیٹ ویو (گرمی کی لہر) کی صورت حال پیدا ہونے کی توقع۔ جس کے باعث:

- پشاور، صوابی، نوشہرہ، مردان، کوہاٹ، اسلام آباد، راولپنڈی، انک، چکوال، جہلم، لاہور، گجرات، گوجرانوالہ، حافظ آباد، منڈی بہاؤ الدین، سیالکوٹ، نارووال، اوکاڑہ، قصور، فیصل آباد، مظفر آباد، میرپور، کوٹلی اور بھمبر میں زیادہ سے زیادہ درجہ حرارت معمول سے 05 سے 07 ڈگری سینٹی گریڈ اضافے کے ساتھ 42 سے 45 ڈگری سینٹی گریڈ پہنچ سکتا ہے۔

- مالاکنڈ، ہزارہ ڈویژن کے اضلاع، گلگت بلتستان، باغ، راولا کوٹ، نیلم ویلی، حویلی اور سدھوتی میں زیادہ سے زیادہ درجہ حرارت معمول سے 05 سے 07 ڈگری سینٹی گریڈ اضافے کے ساتھ 38 سے 40 ڈگری سینٹی گریڈ پہنچ سکتا ہے۔

- سکھر، شکارپور، قمبر شہداد کوٹ، جبیب آباد، لاڑکانہ، موہن جوڑو، دادو، شہید بینظیر آباد، تھرپاکر، بدین، سجاول، ٹھٹہ، حیدر آباد، ٹیاری، ٹنڈو محمد خان، عمرکوٹ، گھوٹکی، خیرپور، نوشہرہ فیروز، میرپور خاص، جامشورو، ساگھڑ، سبی، تربت، پٹنجا، ڈیرہ اسماعیل خان، بنوں، کرک، لکی مروت، وزیرستان، ڈیرہ غازی خان، ملتان، خانیوال، پاکپتن، رحیم یار خان، راجن پور، بہاولپور، بہاولنگر، بھکر، لیہ، کوٹ ادو، سرگودھا، جوہر آباد، خوشاب، میانوالی، نورپور تھل، جھنگ، ٹوبہ ٹیک سنگ اور ساہیوال میں زیادہ سے زیادہ درجہ حرارت معمول سے 04 سے 06 ڈگری سینٹی گریڈ اضافے کے ساتھ 47 سے 50 ڈگری سینٹی گریڈ پہنچ سکتا ہے۔

- اس دوران کراچی میں موسم شدید گرم رہنے کا امکان ہے جبکہ زیادہ سے زیادہ درجہ حرارت 35 سے 38 ڈگری سینٹی گریڈ رہنے کی توقع ہے۔
- اس دوران رات کے درجہ حرارت میں بھی اضافے کا امکان ہے۔

مکنہ اثرات اور احتیاطی تدابیر:

- ہیٹ ویو کی صورت حال کے پیش نظر عوام الناس خصوصاً بچوں، خواتین اور بزرگ شہریوں کو احتیاطی تدابیر اختیار کرنے کی ہدایت۔
- کاشتکار حضرات موسمی حالات کے مطابق اپنی فصلوں کی دیکھ بھال کریں اور اپنے مویشیوں کا بھی خاص خیال رکھیں۔
- عوام الناس کو ہدایت کی جاتی ہے کہ غیر ضروری طور پر دھوپ میں نکلنے سے گریز کریں (خصوصاً 10 سے 04 بجے کے دوران) اور اپنے جسم کو پانی کی کمی سے محفوظ رکھنے کے لیے زیادہ سے زیادہ پانی استعمال کریں۔
- اس دوران بجلی کی طلب / کھیت میں اضافہ ہو سکتا ہے۔
- عوام کو زندگی کے تمام شعبوں میں پانی کے درست استعمال کی ہدایت۔
- نوٹ: تمام متعلقہ اداروں کو ”ارٹ“ رہنے اور کسی ناخوشگوار واقعہ سے بچنے کے لیے تمام ضروری اقدامات کرنے کی ہدایت کی جاتی ہے۔
