**Subject: HEATWAVE CONDITIONS PREDICTED IN THE COUNTRY DURING EID  
HOLIDAYS**

Pakistan Meteorological Department has informed that a high pressure area is developed in upper atmosphere and likely to strengthen further from tomorrow. Under the influence of this system:

- Maximum temperature is likely to remain **04 – 06 °C above normal** and may rise to **(47 - 50) °C** in Sukkur, Shikarpur, Kambar Shahdadkot, Jacobabad, Larkano, Dadu, Shaheed Benazirabad, Ghotki, Khairpur, and Naushahro Feroz districts.
- Maximum temperature may rise **(44 - 47) °C** in Tharparkar, Badin, Hyderabad, Matiari, Tando Muhammad Khan, Umerkot, Mirpurkhas, Jamshoro & Sanghar districts till **31<sup>st</sup> May**.

**Possible Impacts & Advice:**

- **Due to heatwave condition, general public especially children, women, and senior citizens are advised to be extra cautious.**
- **Farmers are advised to manage their crop activities, keeping in view the weather conditions and take care of their livestock as well.**
- **General public is advised to avoid unnecessary exposure to direct sunlight from (1000 to 1600 PST) and remain hydrated.**
- **Electricity demand / consumption may increase during the forecast period.**
- **Judicious use of water is requested in all aspects of life.**
- **General public is also advised to perform qurbani either before or after peak heat hours and carry out activities in covered or shaded areas.**

In view of above, the concerned Deputy Commissioner(s)/Chairmen DDMA(s), line departments and other relevant authorities are requested to take necessary precautionary measures in accordance with the Heatwave SOPs already communicated by this Authority **vide letter No. PDMA(S)/7/(78)/15/363** dated: **14-04-2026**, besides take all additional remedial measures for reducing Heatwave impacts

**Note: All concerned authorities are advised to remain vigilant and take necessary measures, including ensuring the availability of “Drinking Water” in Bakra Mandis/ Bakra Pirris of respective areas during the forecast period.**
