**Subject: MONSOON RAINS PREDICATED IN THE COUNTRY FROM 03<sup>rd</sup> TO 08<sup>th</sup> JULY, 2023**

Pakistan Meteorological Department has informed that the rain/wind-thundershower with isolated heavy falls is also expected in Sukkur, Jacobabad, Ghotki, Shaheed Benazirabad, Larkana, Mithi, Chhor, Padidan, Nagarparkar, Tharparkar, Umerkot, Sanghar, Mirpurkhas, Dadu, Thatta, Badin, Hyderabad and Karachi on **07<sup>th</sup> July and 08<sup>th</sup> July** (Copy Enclosed).

Keeping in view above, it is recommended that concerned Deputy Commissioners/ Chairman DDMA's and other relevant authorities/ stakeholders may take all necessary mitigation measures. including:

- Establish proactive coordination with Provincial Emergency Operation Center (PEOC) PDMA Sindh for vigilant monitoring of weather system.
- Ensure arrangement for removal of fallen trees, wires and other loose structures like electric poles, solar panels etc.
- Ensure cleaning of internal nullahs, drains and choke points.
- Ensure functionality of pumping stations.
- Ensure placement of de-watering pumps and generators across the vulnerable points as needed.
- Establishment of helpline number to facilitate/address the needs of general public at priority basis.
- People may be advised not to park their vehicles near weak structures.
- Stockpile necessary emergency relief/ medicine stores.
- Ensure availability of uninterrupted power supply through intimate coordination with concerned line departments and provision / availability of standby generators for hospitals.
- Emergency services and ambulances with trained paramedics to remain available round the clock at the hospitals.
- Ensure coordination with Rescue 1122 Authorities.
- Ensure that the tools and materials needed for quick response and recovery operations, such as clearing roads and resuming utility services, are readily available.
- Coordinate with concerned departments (NHA, NH&MP and FWO) for issuing necessary alerts to travelers, especially over long distances to take precautions and avoid over exposure to rainfall.

**FOR GENERAL PUBLIC/IDPs:**

- Monitor the weather alerts through print and electronic media.
- Travelers and tourist are advised to remain cautious to avoid any untoward situation during the forecast period.
- Farmers are advised to manage their agricultural activities keeping in view the weather forecast.
- Stay indoor unless absolutely necessary. Keep doors and windows shut and avoid sitting near windows as rain is often accompanied by strong winds.
- Maintain a distance from power lines or electrical wires. If you notice any loose electric wires in your area, alert the concerned authorities immediately.
- Avoid touching electrical switches or outlets while it is raining. Do not try using electrical sockets or outlets outdoors while it is raining.
- Avoid driving in heavy rain because of poor visibility.
- Avoid underpasses, drainage ditches, low-lying areas and areas where water collects.
- Check on family members who are especially at risk from weather hazards: young children, older adults, and the chronically ill.

**Press Release:**

**Monsoon Rains predicted in the Country from 03<sup>rd</sup> to 08<sup>th</sup> July, 2023**

Met Office informed that moist currents from Arabian sea are likely to penetrate in upper parts of the country and a westerly wave is also likely to enter in the upper parts of the country on 03<sup>rd</sup> July (evening/night). Under the influence of these weather systems:

- Rain/wind-thundershower (with few heavy falls /hailstorm) is expected in Islamabad, Rawalpindi, Murree, Galliyat, Attock, Chakwal, Jhelum, Kashmir, Gilgit Baltistan, Chitral, Swat, Mansehra, Kohistan, Abbottabad, Haripur, Peshawar, Mardan, Swabi, Nowshera, Kurram, Bannu, Lakki Marwat, Kohat, Mianwali, Sargodha, Hafizabad, Mandi Bahauddin, Sialkot, Narowal, Lahore, Gujranwala, Gujrat, Sheikhupura, Faisalabad, Jhang and Toba Tek Singh from **03<sup>rd</sup> (evening/night) to 08<sup>th</sup> July** with occasional gaps.
- Rain/wind-thundershower with isolated heavy falls is also expected in Barkhan, Loralai, Sibbi, Naseerabad, Kalat, Khuzdar, Zhob, Lasbella, Awaran, Musakhel, D.I Khan, Bannu, Karak, Waziristan, D.G Khan, Rajanpur, Multan, Bhakkar, Layyah, Kot Addu, Bahawalpur, Bahawalnagar, Sahiwal and Okara from **05<sup>th</sup> to 08<sup>th</sup> July**.
- Rain/wind-thundershower with isolated heavy falls is also expected in Sukkur, Jacobabad Ghotki, Shaheed Benazirabad, Larkana, Mithi, Chhor, Padidan, Nagarparkar, Tharparkar, Umerkot, Sanghar, Mirpur Khas, Dadu, Thatta, Badin, Hyderabad and Karachi on **07<sup>th</sup> July and 08<sup>th</sup> July**.

**Impacts and Advises:**

- Heavy rain may cause urban flooding in low lying areas of Islamabad, Rawalpindi, Peshawar, Gujranwala, Lahore and may trigger landslides in the vulnerable areas of Murree, Galliyat, Kashmir, Gilgit Baltistan and hilly areas of Khyber Pakhtunkhwa from **04<sup>th</sup> to 07<sup>th</sup> July**.
- Heavy falls may cause flash flood in hill torrent areas of D.G. Khan and adjoining areas of northeast Balochistan from **06<sup>th</sup> to 08<sup>th</sup> July**.
- Farmers are advised to manage their activities keeping in view the weather forecast.
- Tourists are advised to remain extra cautious to avoid any untoward situation during the wet spell.
- Loose structures like electric poles, solar panels etc may damage during dust storm/wind-thunderstorm & heavy falls and general public is advised to stay at safe places during the period.

مغربی مونسون کے مطابق بحیرہ عرب سے مرطوب ہوا جس ملک کے پائانی علاقوں میں داخل ہو رہی ہے۔ 03 جولائی (شام ارات) سے مغربی ہواؤں کا سلسلہ ملک کے پائانی علاقوں میں داخل ہو گا۔ جس کے باعث:

- **03 جولائی (شام ارات) سے 08 جولائی** کے دوران اسلام آباد، راولپنڈی، مری، گلگت، ایبٹ آباد، چکوال، جہلم، کشمیر، گلگت، بلتستان، چترال، سوات، مانسہرہ، کوہستان، ایبٹ آباد، ہری پور، پشاور، مردان، مہمانی، نوشہرہ، گرم، انجی، مروت، کوہاٹ، مینوالی، سرگودھا، حافظ آباد، منڈی بہاؤ الدین، سیالکوٹ، تارووال، لاہور، گوجرانوالہ، گجرات، شیخوپورہ، فیصل آباد، چنگ اور ٹوبہ ٹیک سنگھ میں تیز ہواؤں آتے گی اور گرن چنک کے ساتھ بارش جبکہ بعض مقامات پر تیز موسلا دھار بارش اور ڈالہ بارش کا بھی امکان۔
- **05 سے 08 جولائی** کے دوران پاکستان، لورالائی، سی، نصیر آباد، قلات، خضدار، ڈوب، اسپیلہ، آواران، موٹی نیکل ڈی آئی خان، جنوں، کرک، وزیرستان، ڈی بی خان، درابن پور، ملتان، بھکر، لیہ، کوٹ لوہ، بہاولپور، بہاولنگر، ساہیوال اور اڑکھڑ میں تیز ہواؤں آتے گی اور گرن چنک کے ساتھ بارش جبکہ چند مقامات پر تیز موسلا دھار بارش کا بھی امکان۔
- **07 اور 08 جولائی** کے دوران سکس، جیکب آباد، گھوٹکی، شہید ظفر آباد، اڑکھڑ، مٹی، چھوڑ، پٹنہ، مٹی، گجر پور، تھر پور، عمرکوٹ، ساکنڈ، میر پور خاص، دادو، ٹھٹھہ، مہدین، حیدر آباد اور کراچی میں تیز ہواؤں آتے گی اور گرن چنک کے ساتھ بارش جبکہ چند مقامات پر تیز موسلا دھار بارش کا بھی امکان۔
