**Subject** **SEVERE CYCLONIC STORM (SCS) OVER SOUTHWEST ARABIAN SEA**

Pakistan Meteorological Department has informed that the **Cyclonic Storm (TEJ)** over Southwest Arabian Sea moved further west-northwestward, intensified into a **Severe Cyclonic Storm (SCS)** and now lies centred around Latitude **11.0°N** & Longitude **57.0°E** at a distance of about **1880km** southwest of Karachi, **1670km** south/southwest of Gwadar & **750km** south-southeast of Salalah (Oman). Maximum sustained surface winds are **100-110 Km/h** gusting **120 Km/h**, sea conditions very high/phenomenal & maximum wave height is **25** feet around the system center. Due to highly favorable environmental conditions (warm SSTs, low vertical wind shear and upper-level outflow), the system is likely to strengthen further into a **Very Severe Cyclonic Storm (VSCS)** by tomorrow and keep moving in west-northwest direction towards Yemen-Oman coast. No Impact on any of Pakistan coastal area from this system.

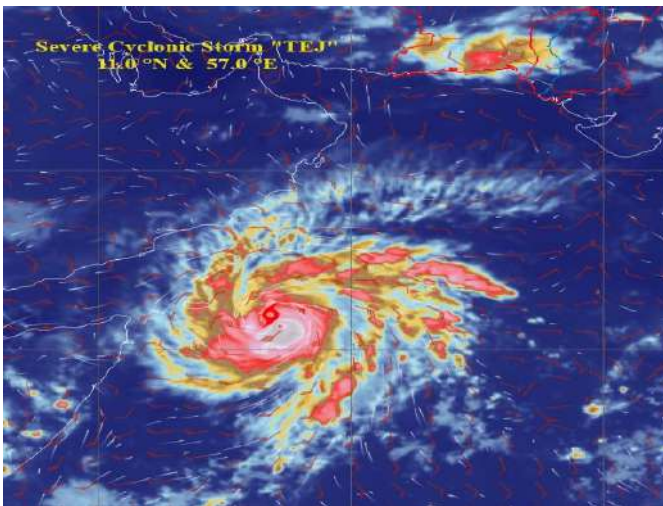

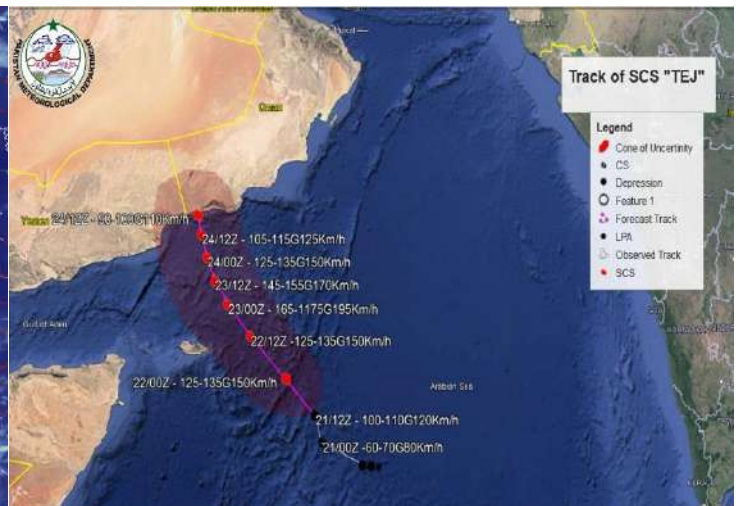
## **Severe Cyclonic Storm (SCS) over Southwest Arabian Sea**
