Subject **MODERATE MONSOON CURRENTS FROM BAY OF BENGAL ARE LIKELY TO PENETRATE IN PARTS OF THE COUNTRY**

Pakistan Meteorological Department has informed that moderate monsoon currents from Bay of Bengal are likely to penetrate in the country from **15th to 20th September**. A westerly wave is also likely to enter in some parts of the country. Under the influence of this weather system, rain/wind-thunderstorm is expected in Mirpurkhas, Khairpur, Tharparkar, Umerkot and Sanghar districts from **16th (evening/night) to 18th September**.

POSSIBLE IMPACTS

- Prevailing very hot and humid conditions are likely to subside during the spell.
- Farmers are advised to manage their crop activities accordingly.
- Tourists and travelers are advised to remain cautious to avoid any untoward situation during the period.
- Wind-thunderstorm may damage loose structures like electric poles, solar panels etc.
- General public is advised to stay at safe places during wind-storm/lightning/heavy rains.

2. In view of the above, the Concerned Deputy Commissioner(s)/ Chairman DDMA(s) are requested to take necessary precautionary measures.

Rain-wind/Thunderstorm predicted from 15th to 20th September with occasional gaps

Met Office informed that moderate monsoon currents from Bay of Bengal are likely to penetrate in upper parts of the country from 15th (evening/night). A westerly wave is also likely to enter in these areas on 16th September. Under the influence of this:

Rain/wind-thunderstorm (with few moderate to isolated heavy falls) is expected in Kashmir, (Neelum valley, Muzaffarabad, Poonch, Hattian, Bagh, Haveli, Sudhanoti, Kotli, Bhimber, Mirpur), Gilgit Baltistan (Diamir, Astore, Ghizer, Skardu, Hunza, Gilgit, Ghanche, Shigar), Murree, Galliyat, Islamabad, Rawalpindi, Attock, Chakwal, Jhelum, Mandi Bahauddin, Hafizabad, Gujranwala, Gujrat, Sialkot, Narowal, Lahore, Kasur, Sheikhpura, Chitral, Dir, Swat, Shangla, Buner, Mansehra, Kohistan, Abbottabad, Haripur, Kohat, Peshawar, Mardan, Swabi and Nowshera from **15th (evening/night) to 20th September** with occasional gaps.

- Rain/wind-thunderstorm is also expected in Kurram, Lakki Marwat, Dera Ismail Khan, Bannu, Karak, Waziristan, Mianwali, Sargodha, Khushab, Faisalabad, Toba Tek Singh, Jhang and Bhakkar from **16th (evening/night) to 18th September** with occasional gaps while, in Dera Ghazi Khan, Rajanpur, Musa Khel, Barkhan, Zhob, Kalat, Khuzdar, Mirpurkhas, Khairpur, Tharparkar, Umer Kot and Sanghar during the period.

Impacts and Advises:

- Moderate to heavy falls may increase the water flows in local Nullahs/streams of Kashmir, Gilgit-Baltistan, Chitral, Dir, Swat, Kohistan, Shangla, Buner, Mansehra, Abbottabad, Galliyat, Murree, Rawalpindi/Islamabad from **17th to 19th September**.
- Moderate to heavy rains may trigger landslides in the vulnerable areas of Murree, Galliyat, Kashmir, Gilgit Baltistan, Chitral, Dir, Swat, Kohistan, Shangla, Buner, Mansehra & Abbottabad during the wet spell from **16th to 19th September**.
- Prevailing very hot and humid conditions are likely to subside during the spell.
- Farmers are advised to manage their crop activities accordingly.
- Tourists and travelers are advised to remain cautious to avoid any untoward situation during the period.
- Wind-thunderstorm may damage loose structures like electric poles, solar panels etc.
- General public is advised to stay at safe places during wind-storm/lightning/heavy rains.

All concerned authorities are advised to remain ALERT and take necessary precaution measure during the forecast period.

15 سے 20 ستمبر کے دوران آندھی / تیز ہواؤں اور گرج چمک کے ساتھ وقفے وقفے سے بارش کی پیش گوئی

محلہ موسمیات کے مطابق 15 ستمبر (شام / رات) سے خلیج بنگال سے مونسون ہوائیں ملک کے بالائی علاقوں میں داخل ہوں گی۔ 16 ستمبر کو مغربی ہوائیں بھی ان علاقوں میں داخل ہوں گی۔ جس کے باعث:

- **15 (شام / رات) سے 20 ستمبر کے دوران** کشمیر (وادئیں نیلم، مظفر آباد، پونچھ، بیاس، بارش، حویلی، سدھوتی، کوٹلی، بھمبر، میرپور)، گلگت بلتستان (دیامیر، استور، غدر، اسکردو، ہنزہ، گلگت، گھانچے، شگل، مری، گلگت، اسلام آباد، راولپنڈی، اٹک، چکوال، جہلم، منڈی بہاؤالدین، حافظ آباد، گوجرانوالہ، گجرات، سیالکوٹ، نارووال، قصور، لاہور، شیخوپورہ، چترال، دیر، سوات، شانگلہ، یونیر، مانسہرہ، کوہستان، ایبٹ آباد، ہری پور، کوہاٹ، پشاور، مردان، صوابی اور نوشہرہ میں آندھی / تیز ہواؤں اور گرج چمک کے ساتھ وقفے وقفے سے بارش جبکہ بعض مقامات پر تیز / موسلا دھار بارش کا بھی امکان۔
- **16 (شام / رات) سے 18 ستمبر کے دوران** گرم، کچی مروت، ڈیرہ اسماعیل خان، بنوں، کرک، وزیرستان، میانوالی، سرگودھا، خوشاب، فیصل آباد، ٹوبہ ٹیک سنگھ، جھنگ اور بھکر میں آندھی / تیز ہواؤں اور گرج چمک کے ساتھ وقفے وقفے سے بارش کا امکان۔ اس دوران ڈیرہ غازی خان، راجن پور، موسیٰ خیل، بارکھان، ژوب، قلات، خضدار، میرپور خاص، خیرپور، تھرپاکر، عمرکوٹ اور ساگھڑ میں آندھی / تیز ہواؤں اور گرج چمک کے ساتھ بارش کی توقع۔

مکملہ اثرات اور اقدامات:

- **17 سے 19 ستمبر کے دوران** تیز / موسلا دھار بارش کے باعث کشمیر، گلگت بلتستان، چترال، دیر، سوات، کوہستان، شانگلہ، یونیر، مانسہرہ، ایبٹ آباد، گلگت، مری، راولپنڈی / اسلام آباد کے مقامی اور برساتی ندی نالوں میں پانی کے بہاؤ میں اضافے کا امکان۔
- **16 سے 19 ستمبر کے دوران** تیز / موسلا دھار بارش کے باعث مری، گلگت، کشمیر، گلگت بلتستان، چترال، دیر، سوات، کوہستان، شانگلہ، یونیر، مانسہرہ اور ایبٹ آباد میں لینڈ سلائڈنگ کا بھی خطرہ۔
- بارشوں کے باعث حالیہ گرم اور شدید جس میں کمی کا امکان۔
- کسان حضرات موسمیاتی پیش گوئی کو مد نظر رکھتے ہوئے اپنے معاملات ترتیب دیں۔
- سیاحوں کو بارشوں کے دوران کسی بھی ناخوشگوار صورتحال سے بچنے کے لیے محتاط رہنے کی ہدایت۔
- آندھی / بجھڑ / گرج چمک اور شدید بارشوں کے باعث کمزور انفراسٹرکچر (جلی کے کھبے، سولر بینیل وغیرہ) کو نقصان پہنچ سکتا ہے۔
- آندھی / گرج چمک / شدید بارشوں کے دوران عوام کو محفوظ مقامات پر رہنے کی ہدایت۔
