

Breach in Rohri Canal

The Deputy Commissioner /Chairman DDMA Sanghar informed that today i.e. **04 August at 6:15 a.m**, a breach occurred on the **Rohri Canal, specifically at 825 RD**, near Alam Dero Village. The breach was approximately 50 feet wide, and affected the villages of Alam Dero, Haji Karim Dinu Kori, and Haji Mithan Dero, impacting around 1500 people.

Actions taken by DDMA:

- Affected individuals have been rescued and relocated to Govt School Tando Adam and Government School Suikander.
- $\hbox{- The Chief Engineer has been instructed to reduce water discharge to zero level.}\\$
- The plugging the breach is in progress.
- All necessary measures are being taken to address the situation.
