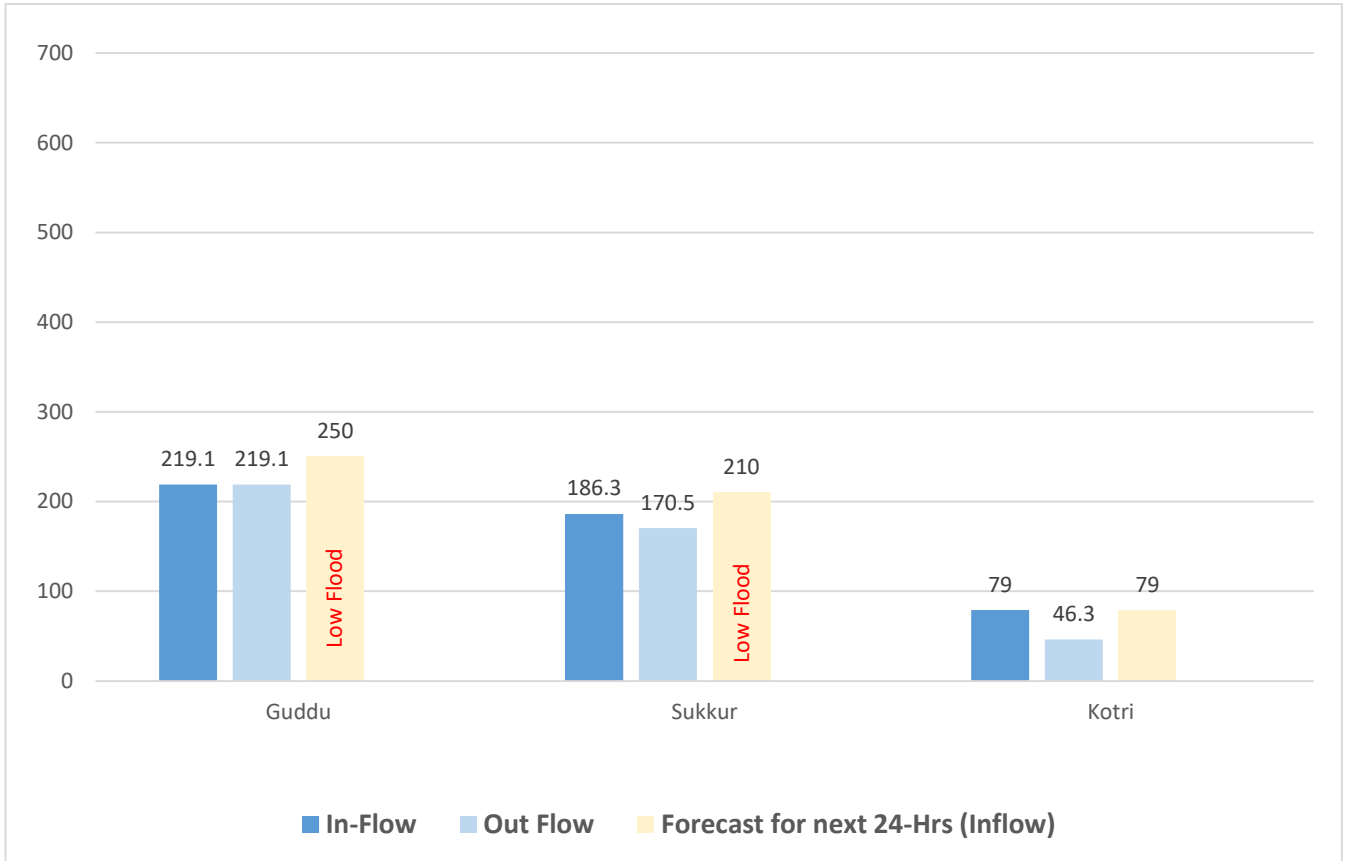

Current Situation of Breach Plugging in Rohri Canal

The Deputy Commissioner /Chairman DDMA Sanghar has informed that on 04.08.2024, a breach about 50 to 55 feet occurred in Rohri Canal at RD 824 near village Alam Khan Dero Taluka Tando Adam. Resultantly, various villages including Alam Dero, Mithan Dero, Jurio Dero, Kareem Dino Chana and Allah Dino Chana were affected.

The District Administration under supervision of Deputy Commissioner Sanghar immediately rushed at the breach site and gear-up the concerned irrigation officers to take prompt action in order to plug off the Breach. About 40% work has so far done by the irrigation staffs, however, the remaining work to plug off the breach will be completed till evening today, as reported by the Executive Engineer, Irrigation Hala Division.

Summary of losses / damages due to breach are as under: -

Actions of District Administration Sanghar: -

1. Expedited the Irrigation officers / officials to immediate plug off the breach.
2. Rescued and shifted the affected population at safer places / relief camps.
3. Supplied cooked food to the affected population (in relief camps and other than relief camps)
4. Provision of clean drinking water.
5. Medical camp with doctors and para medics has been established at the relief camp and mobile teams for outside of relief camps.
6. Established of fixed / mobile team of vaterinary staff, for vaccination and treatment of animals.

Breach in Begari Canal

A breach of 50 feet was discovered at Meeranpur in Begari canal, affecting 150 acres land and approximately 200 houses. The repair/ filling of breach is undergoing under the supervision of DC Jacobabad by the irrigation department. Tents and non-food items were provided to affected people, the following villages affected by the breach:
