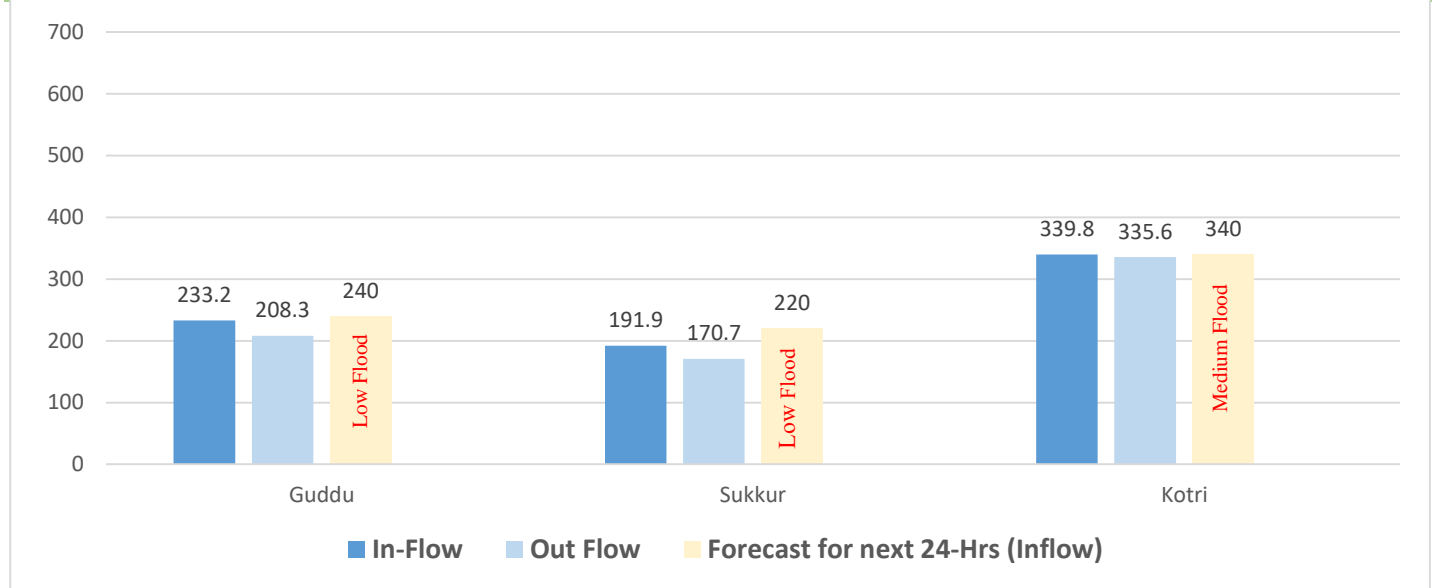
Weather Update Dated 02-09-2024

Pakistan Meteorological Department has informed that monsoon currents are likely to enter in eastern Sindh by tomorrow. Under its influence:

- **Thunderstorm/rain with few moderate to isolated heavy falls** likely in **Thatta, Tharparker, Mirpurkhas, Umerkot, Sanghar, Badin, Jamshoro, Dadu, Matiari, Hyderabad, Tando Muhammad Khan, Tando Allahyar, Shaheed Benazirabad, and Khairpur districts** during **3rd and 4th September** with **occasional gaps**.
- **Thunderstorm/rain** also likely in **Ghotki, Sukkur, Kashmore, Jacobabad, Shikarpur, Larkano, Kambar Shahdadkot, and Naushahro Feroze districts** during **3rd and 4th September** with **occasional gaps**.
- **Isolated thunderstorm/rain** may occur in **Karachi division** on **4th September**.
- The Deep Depression (Remnant of Cyclonic Storm "ASNA") over western Arabian Sea further weakened in to Depression over the same region.

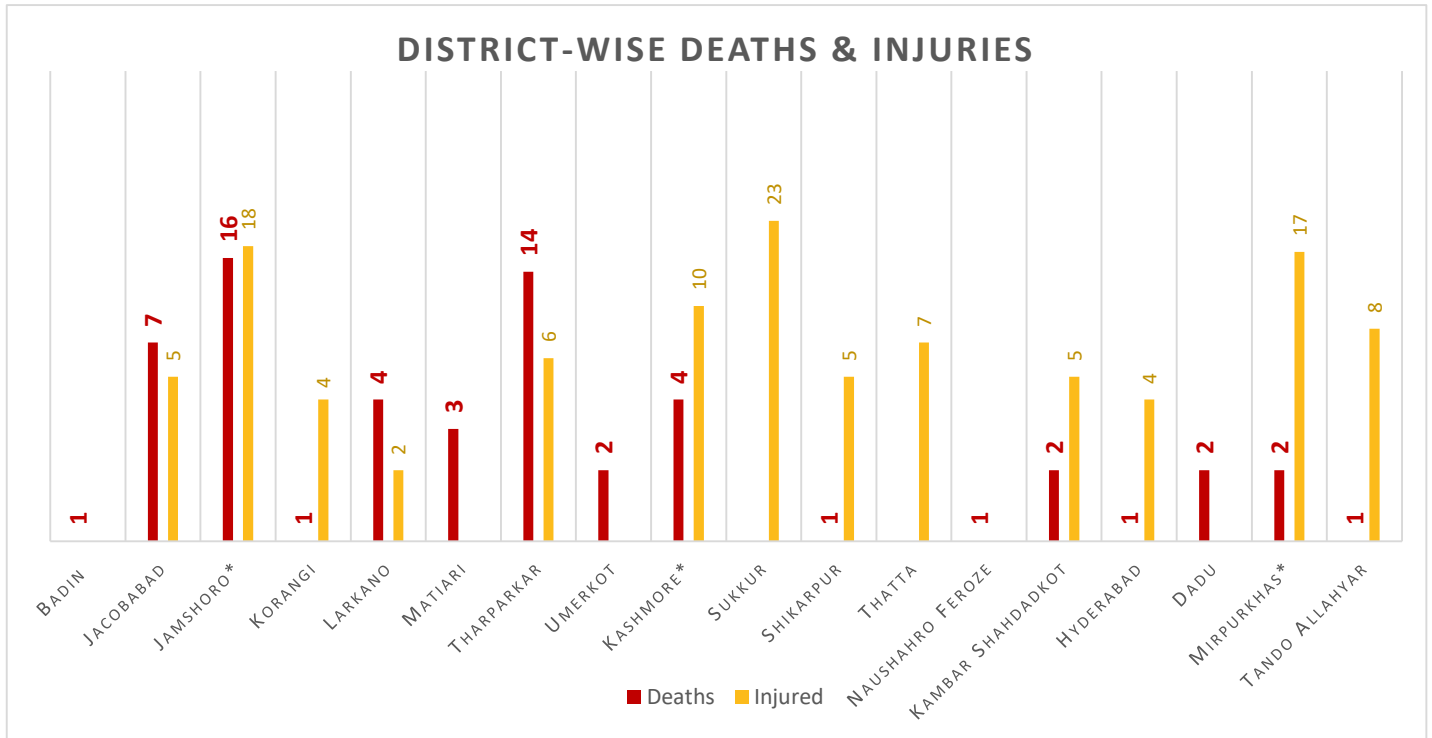

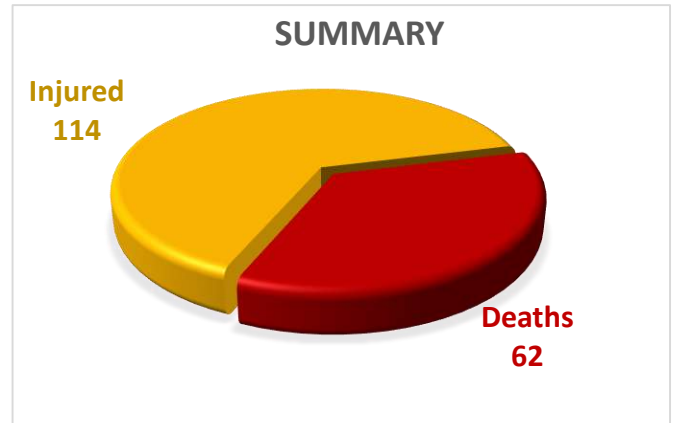
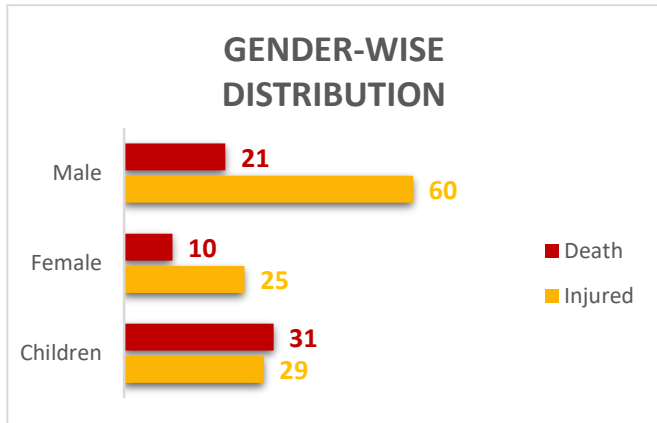
Cumulative Casualties – Deaths / Injuries (31-06-2024 to 02-09-2024)

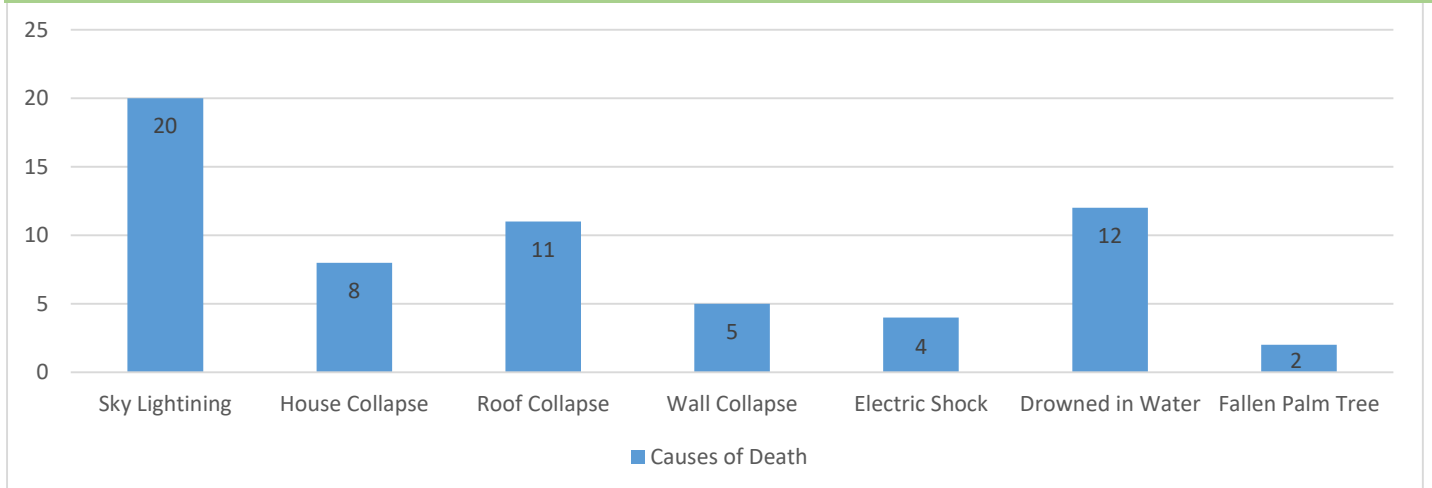

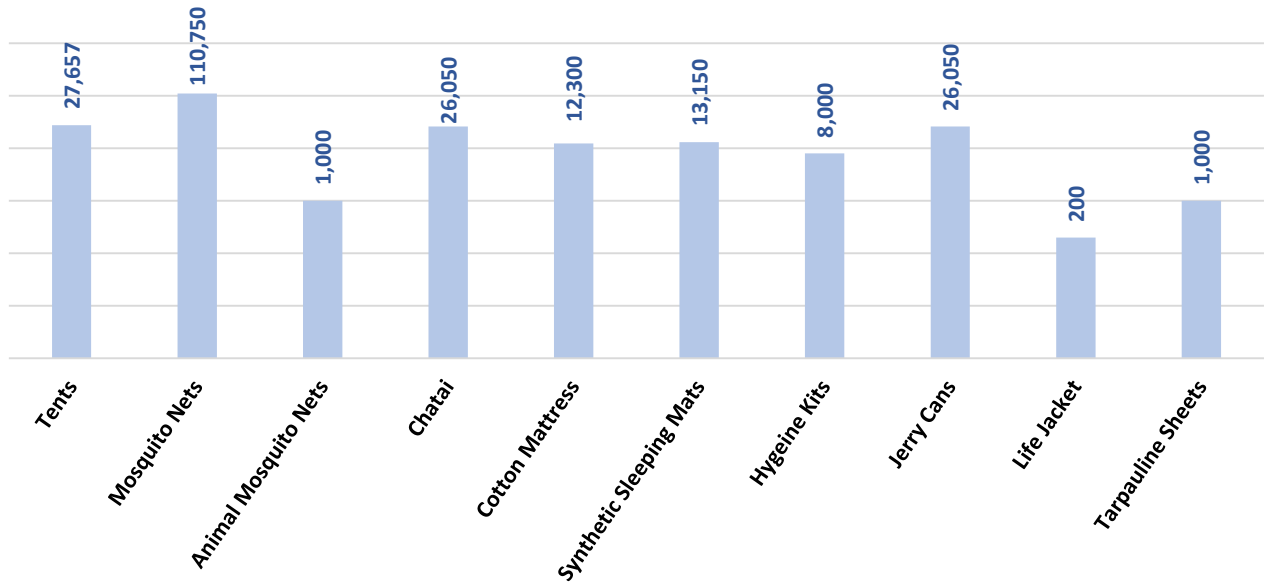
