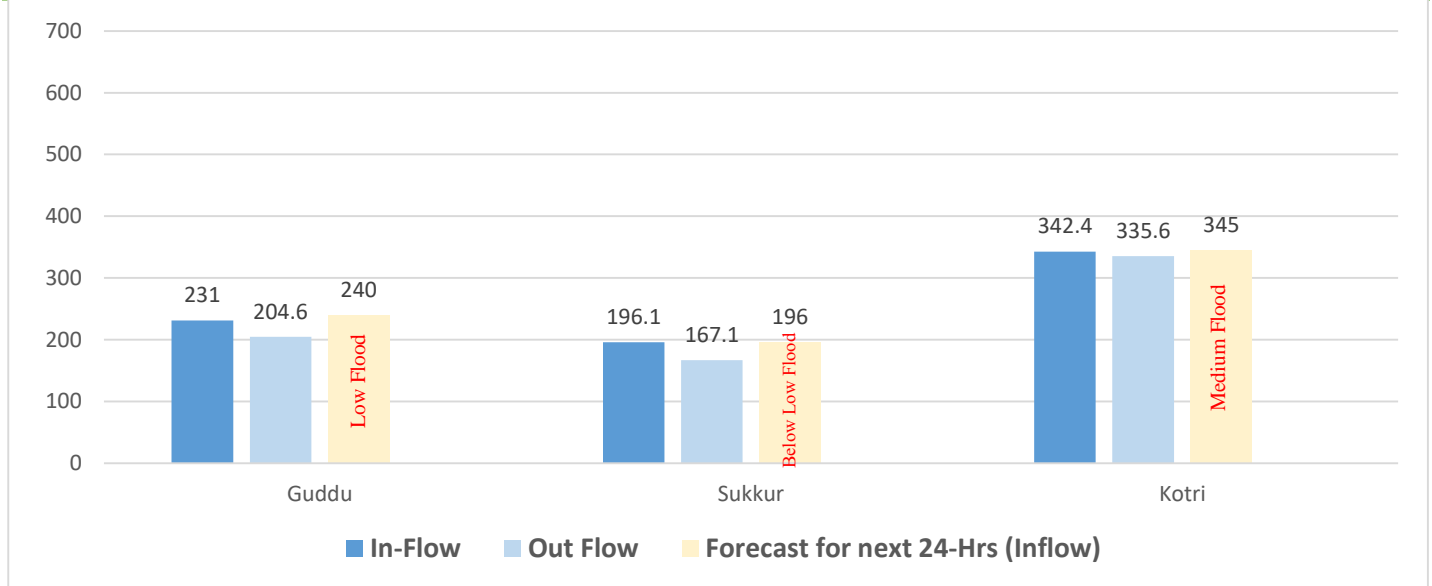
### Weather Update Dated 04-09-2024

Pakistan Meteorological Department has informed that shallow monsoon currents are penetrating into eastern/southeastern Sindh. Under its influence:

- **Thunderstorm/rain with few moderate falls** likely in **Tharparker, Mirpurkhas, Umerkot, Sanghar, Badin, Thatta, Jamshoro, Matiari, Hyderabad, Tando Muhammad Khan, Tando Allahyar, Shaheed Benazirabad, and Khairpur** districts today.
- **Thunderstorm/light rain** also likely in **Dadu, Ghotki, Sukkur, Larkano, Jacobabad, Shikarpur, Kambar Shahdadtkot, and Naushahro Feroze** districts today evening/night.
- **Isolated rain-thunderstorm** may occur at outskirts of **Karachi** division today evening.

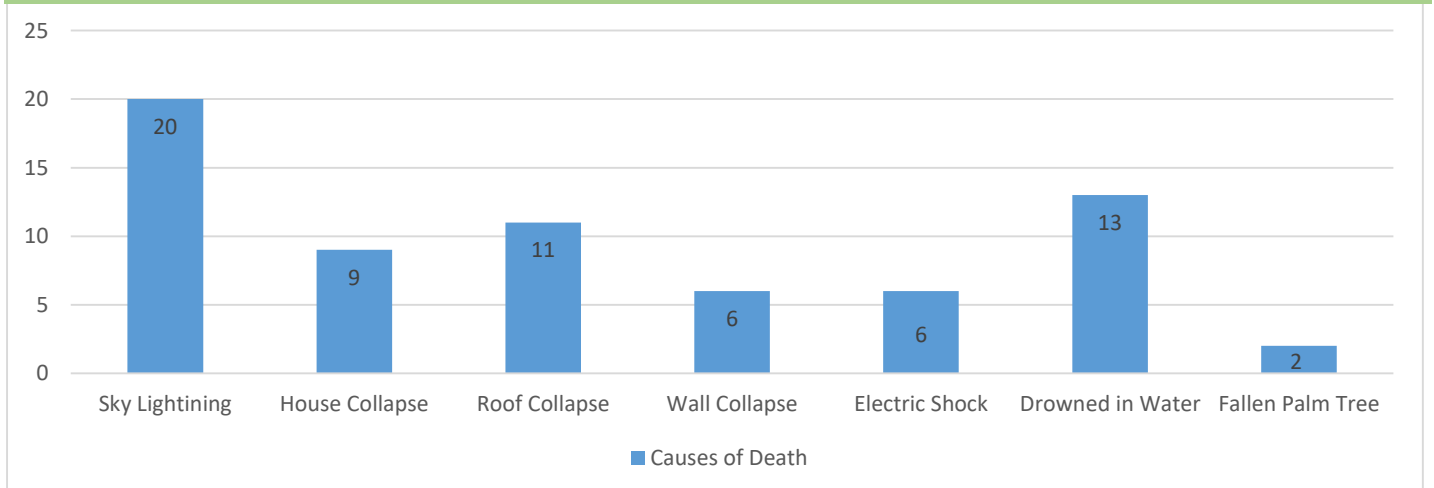


## Cumulative Casualties – Deaths / Injuries (21-06-2024 to 04-09-2024)

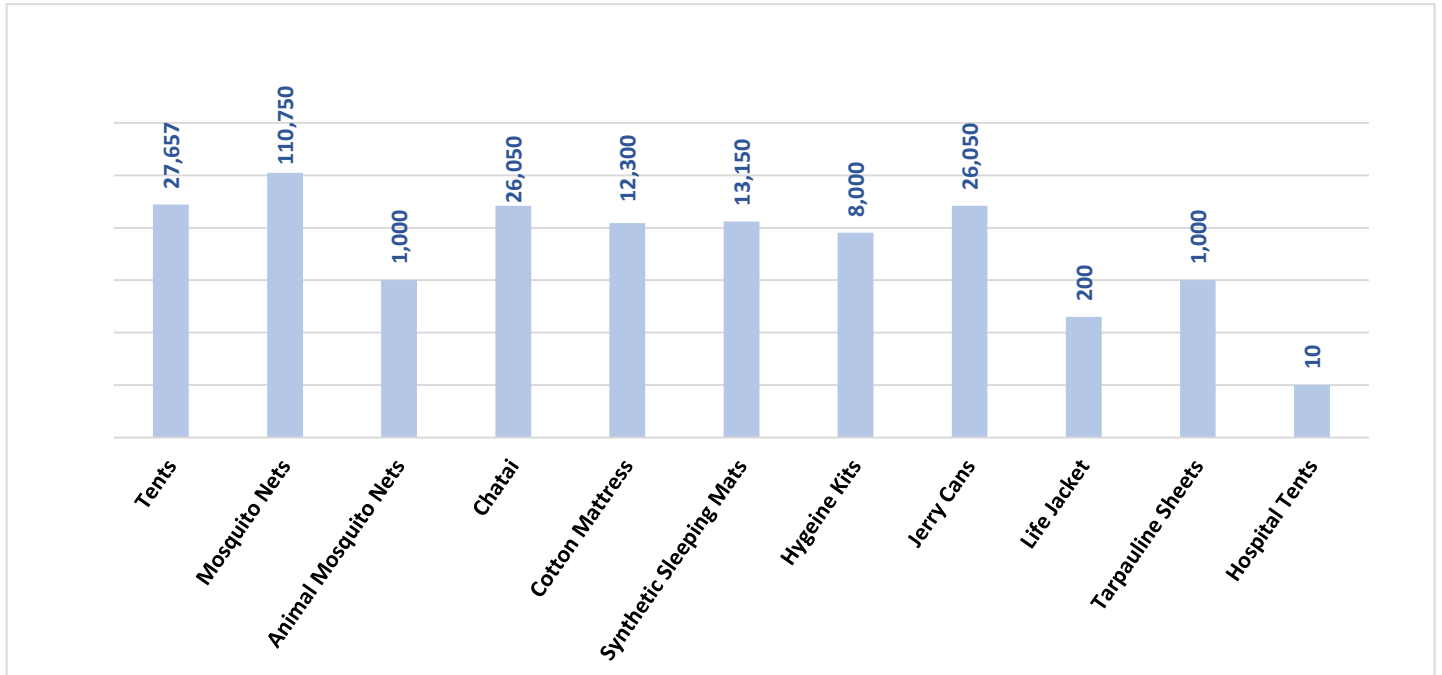
