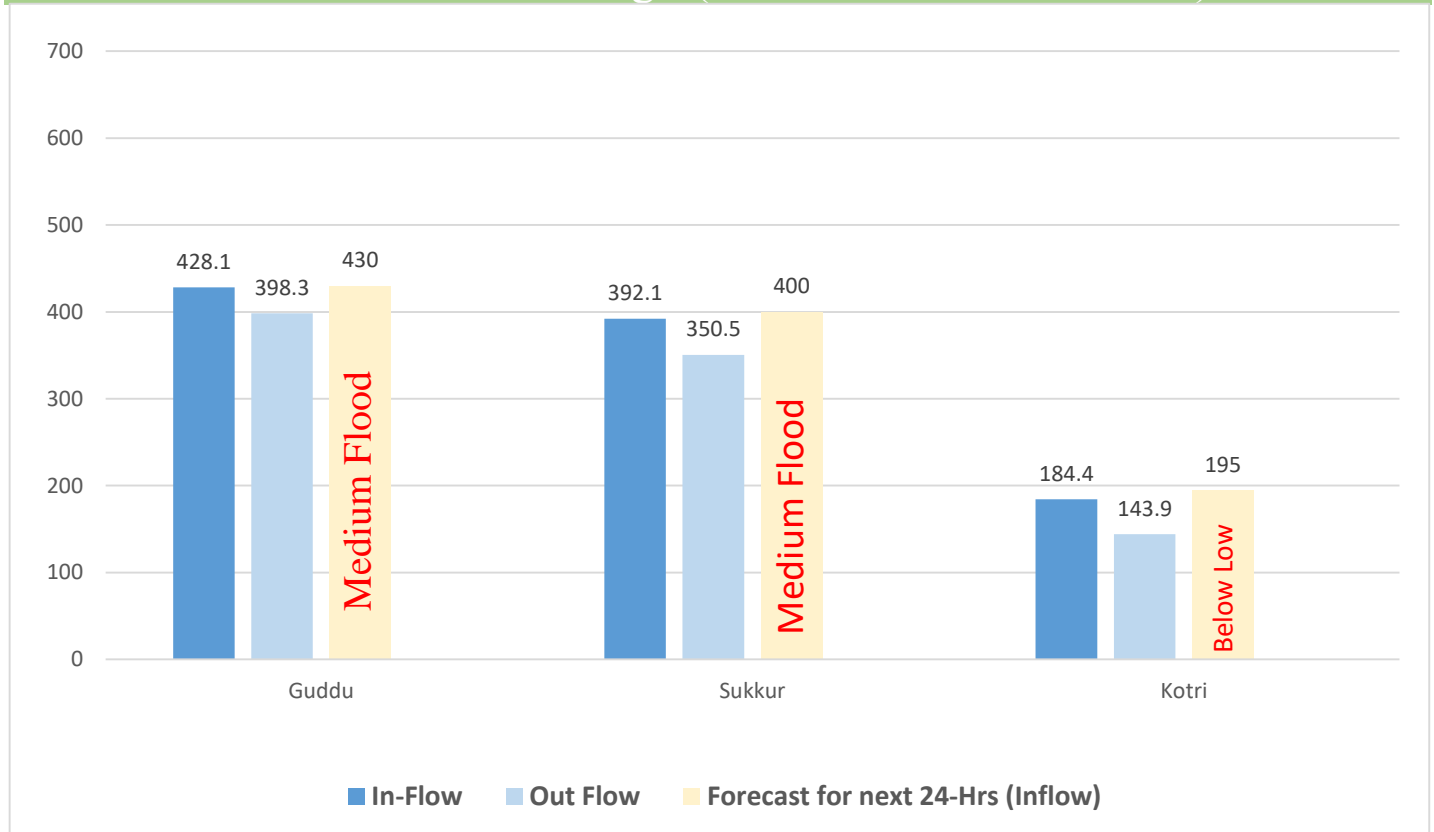
Weather Update Dated: 13-08-2024

Pakistan Meteorological Department has informed that Few Monsoon currents likely to penetrate in eastern Sindh from 16th August. Under its influence:

- Wind-thunderstorm/rain with few **heavy falls** likely in **Mirpur Khas, Umerkot, Sanghar, Jamshoro, Dadu, Thatta, Badin & Sujawal** district during **16th – 19th August** with occasional gaps.
- Wind-thunderstorm/rain likely in **Ghotki, Sukkur, Khairpur, Kashmore, Jacobabad, Shikarpur, Larkana, Kambar Shahdadkot, Naushahro Feroze, Shaheed Benazirabad, Matiari, Hyderabad, Tando Allahyar, Tando Muhammad Khan, Tharparkar** districts & **Karachi** division during **16th – 19th August**.
- Few falls of light rain/drizzle likely in **Tharparkar, Jamshoro, Thatta, Sujawal** districts & **Karachi** division today.

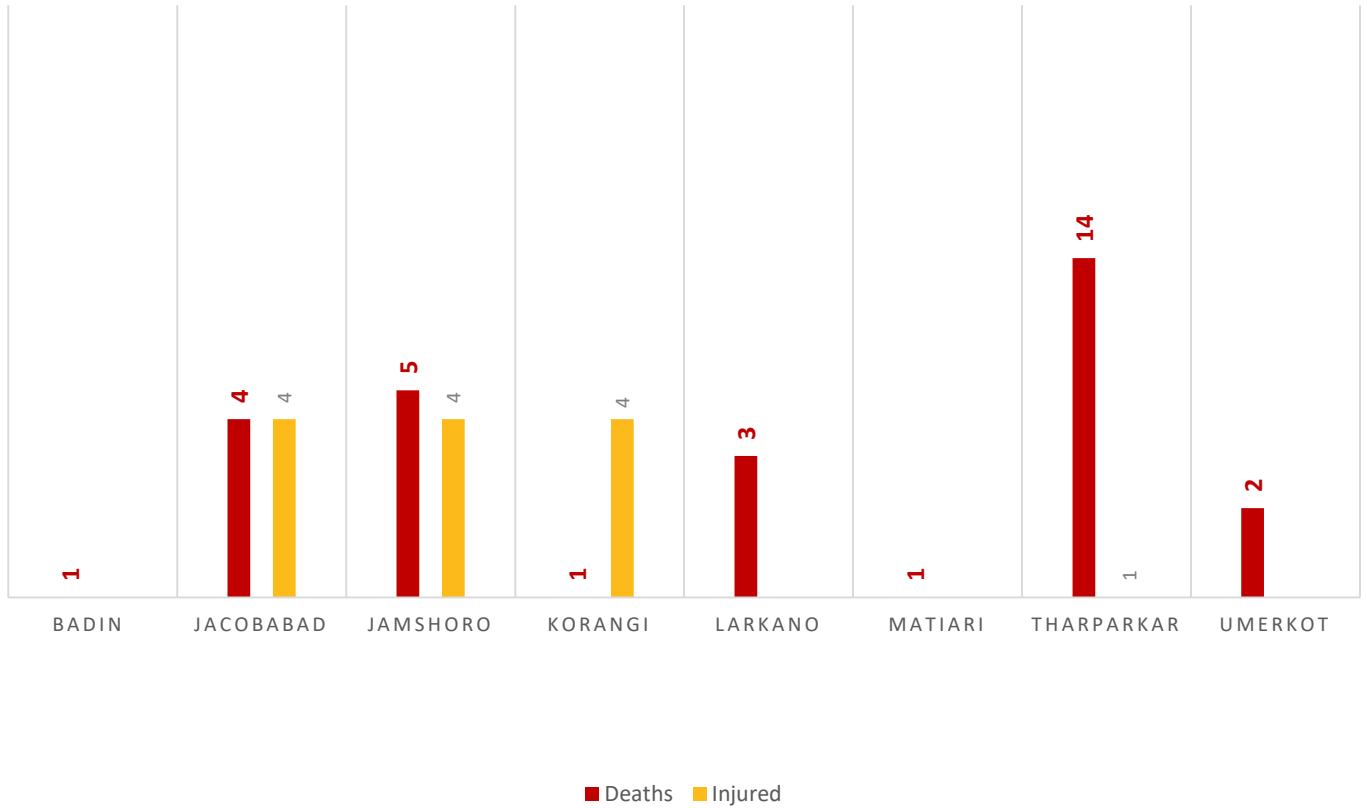

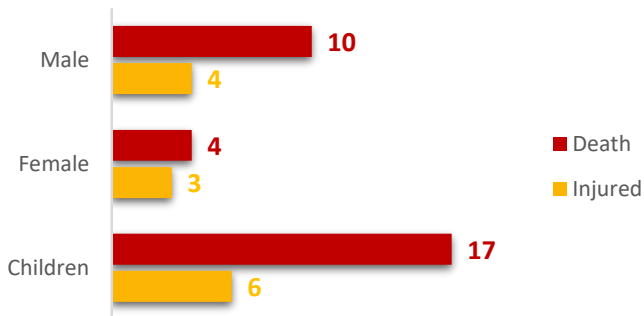

Cumulative Casualties – Deaths / Injuries (21-06-2024 to 13-08-2024)

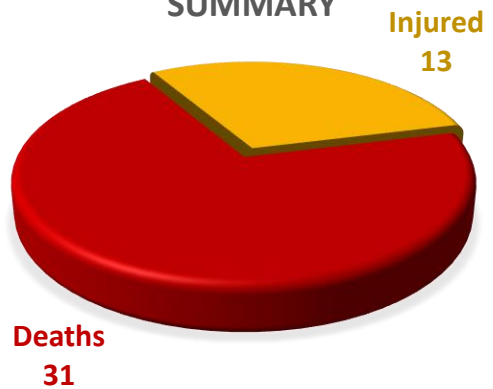
DISTRICT-WISE DEATHS & INJURIES

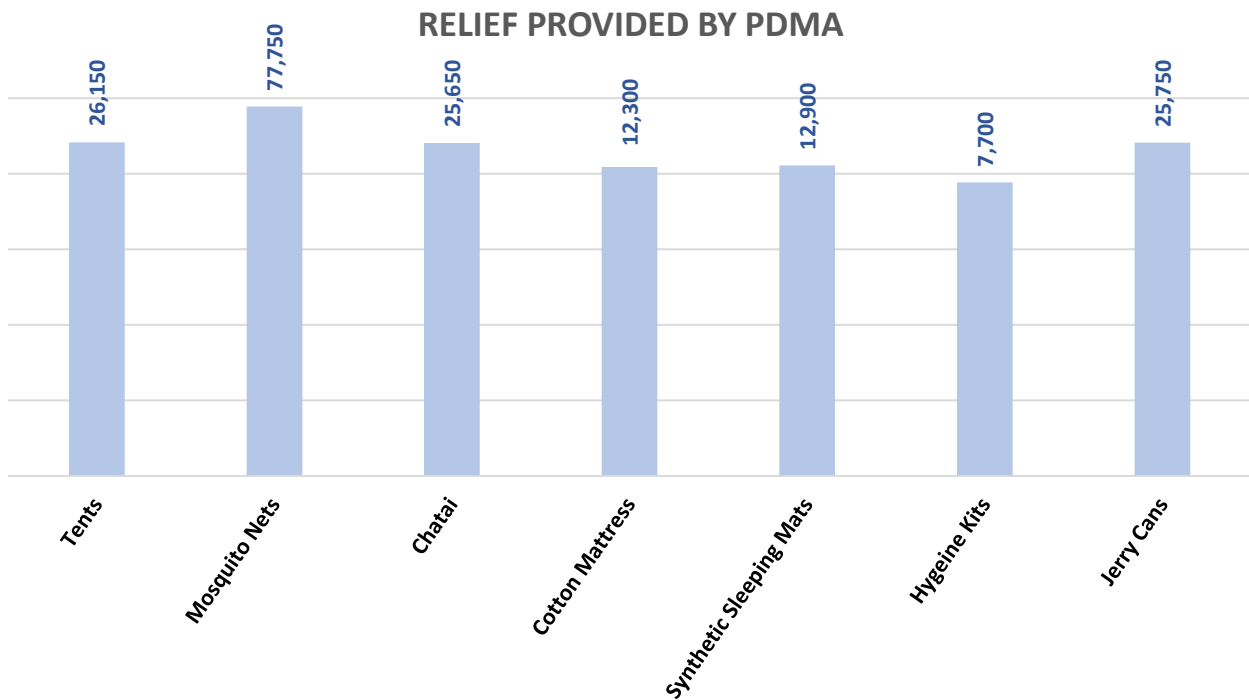
