### Weather Update Dated 26-08-2024

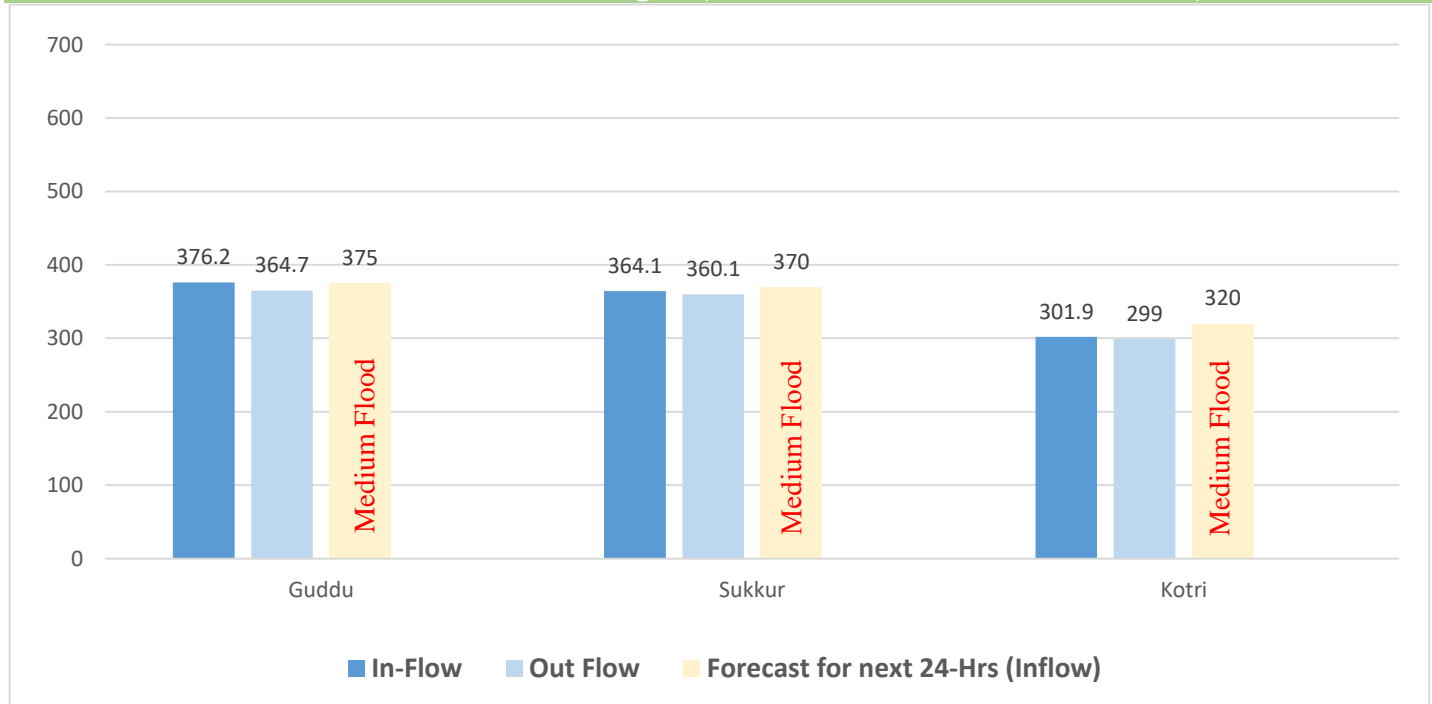
Pakistan Meteorological Department has informed that yesterday's **depression** located over east Rajasthan India moved west-southwestwards & intensified into a **deep depression** over Rajasthan India. It is likely to move further west-southwestward and reach Kutch, Tharparker and adjoining Arabian sea by morning of **29<sup>th</sup> August**. Due to this weather system strong monsoon currents are penetrating in Southeast Sindh. Under its influence:

- **Rain/ wind-thunderstorms** with **scattered heavy-very heavy to isolated extremely heavy falls** likely in **Tharparker, Badin, Thatta, Sujawal, Hyderabad, Tando Muhammad Khan, Tando Allahyar, Matiari, Umerkot, Mirpurkhas, Sanghar, Jamshoro, Dadu, Kambar Shahdadkot, Larkana & Shaheed Benazirabad** districts till **31<sup>st</sup> August** with occasional gaps.
- **Rain/ wind-thunderstorms** with **few heavy to isolated very heavy falls** likely in **Ghotki, Sukkur, Khairpur, Kashmore, Jacobabad & Shikarpur** districts from **today to 30<sup>th</sup> August** with occasional gaps.
- **Wind-thunderstorm/ rain** with **scattered heavy to isolated very heavy falls** also occur in **Karachi Division** during **27<sup>th</sup> – 31<sup>st</sup> August** with occasional gaps.

Flood Forecasting Division of Pakistan Meteorological Department has also informed that **Severe Flash Flooding** is likely to develop in the areas along Kirthar ranges, **Jacobabad, Kambar Shahdadkot, Dadu & Jamshoro** districts from **27<sup>th</sup> to 31<sup>st</sup> August**. Urban Flooding is also expected in the metropolitan cities of Sindh. (Bulletin No. C-073/24 dated: 26th Aug 2024)

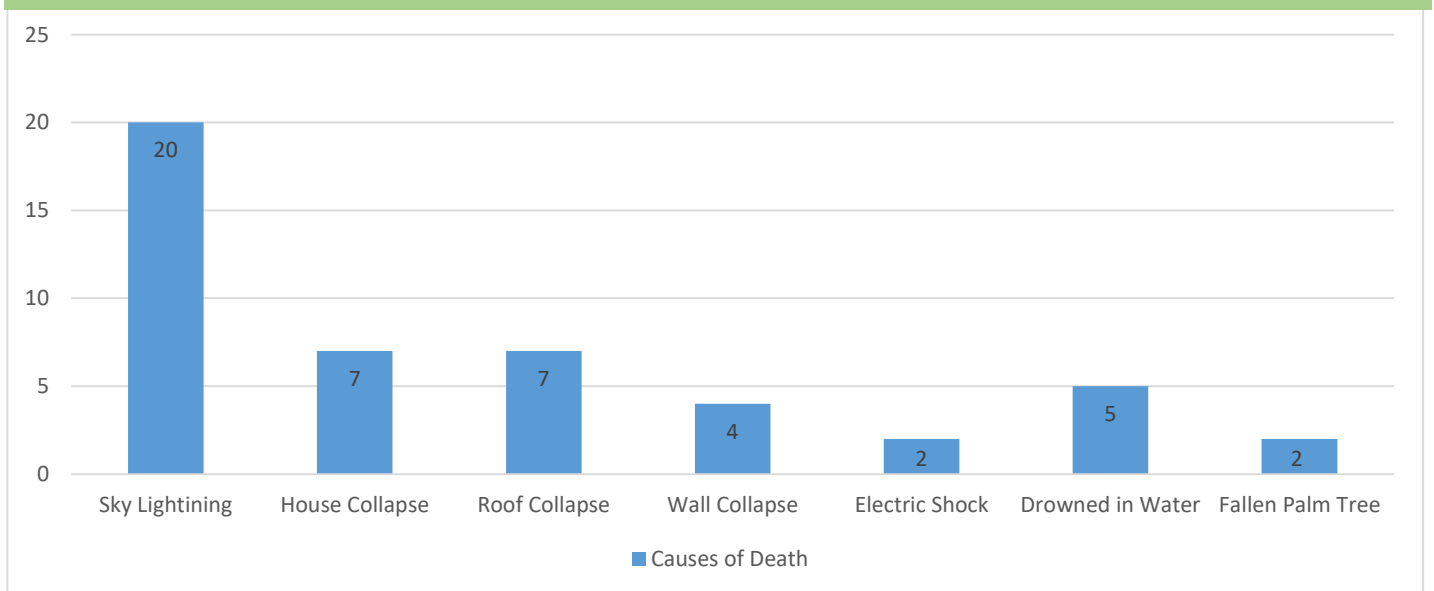


## Cumulative Casualties – Deaths / Injuries (21-06-2024 to 26-08-2024)

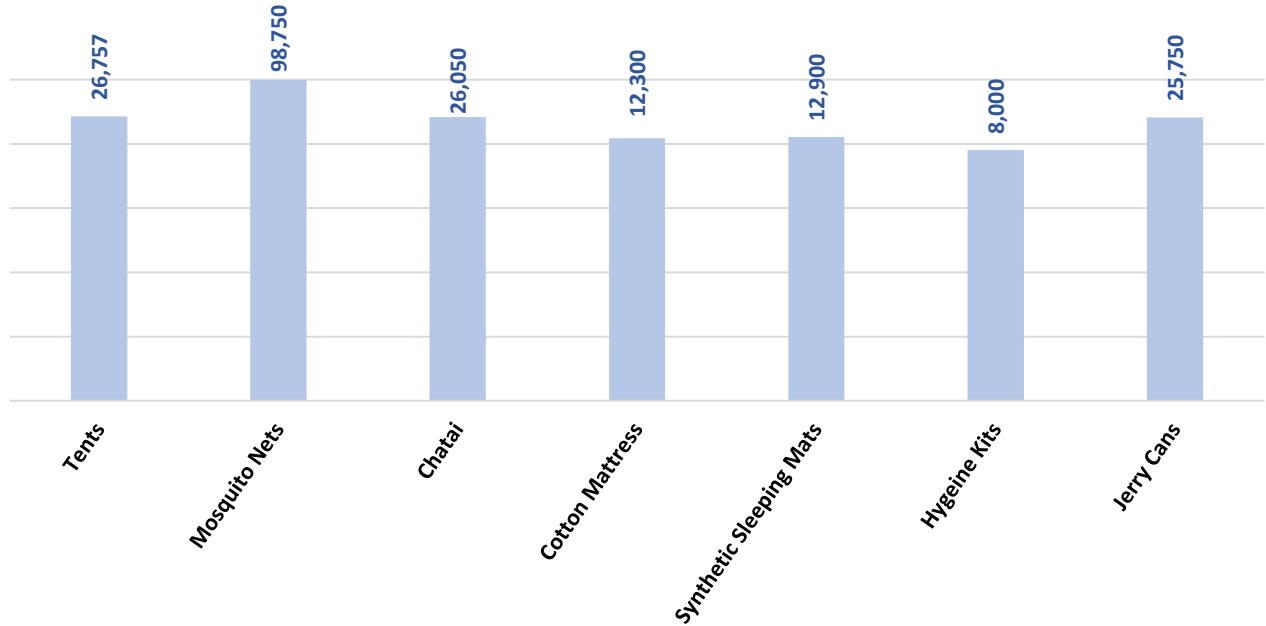
