Weather Update Dated 27-08-2024

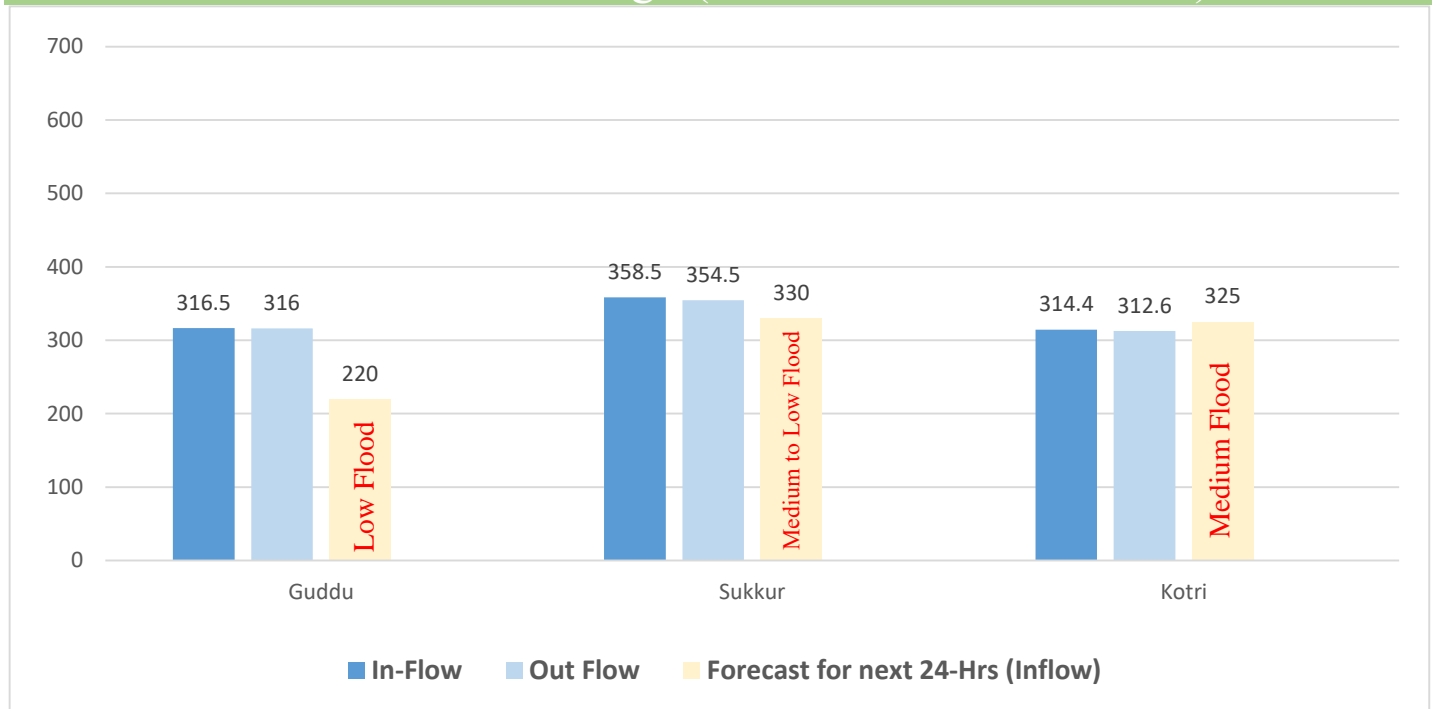
Pakistan Meteorological Department has informed that the **deep depression** over Rajhistan India moved westward and now located over Gujarat India. It is likely to move slowly west-southwestward and reach Rann of Kutch, the Northeast Arabian sea and adjoining Pakistan coast by **28th night/ 29th August morning**. Due to this weather system strong monsoon currents are penetrating in Southeast Sindh. Under its influence:

- **Widespread rain/ wind-thunderstorms** with **scattered heavy-very heavy to isolated extremely heavy falls** likely in **Tharparker, Badin, Thatta, Sujawal, Hyderabad, Tando Muhammad Khan, Tando Allahyar, Matiari, Umerkot, Mirpurkhas, Sanghar, Jamshoro, Dadu, & Shaheed Benazirabad** districts Karachi division till **31st August** with occasional gaps.
- **Rain/ wind-thunderstorms** with **few heavy to isolated very heavy falls** likely in **Ghotki, Sukkur, Khairpur, Kashmore, Kambar Shahdadkot, Larkana, Naushahro Feroze, Jacobabad & Shikarpur** districts till **31st August** with occasional gaps.

Flood Forecasting Division of Pakistan Meteorological Department has also informed that **Severe Flash Flooding** is expected in the areas along Kirthar ranges, **Jacobabad, Kambar Shahdadkot, Dadu & Jamshoro**. Urban Flooding is also expected in the metropolitan cities of Sindh. (Bulletin No. C-074/24 dated: 27th Aug 2024)

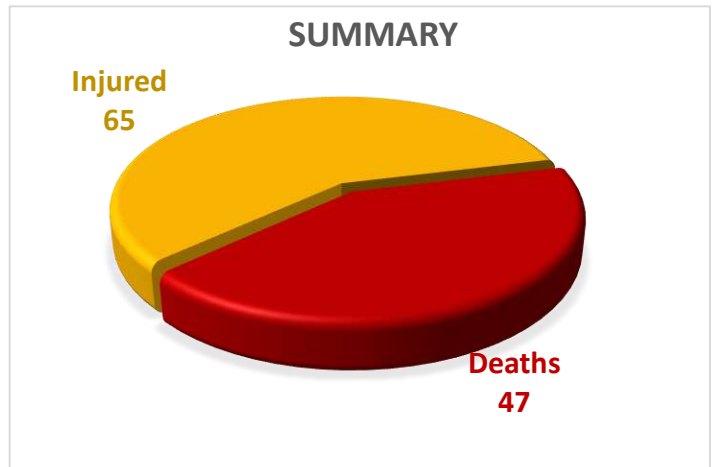

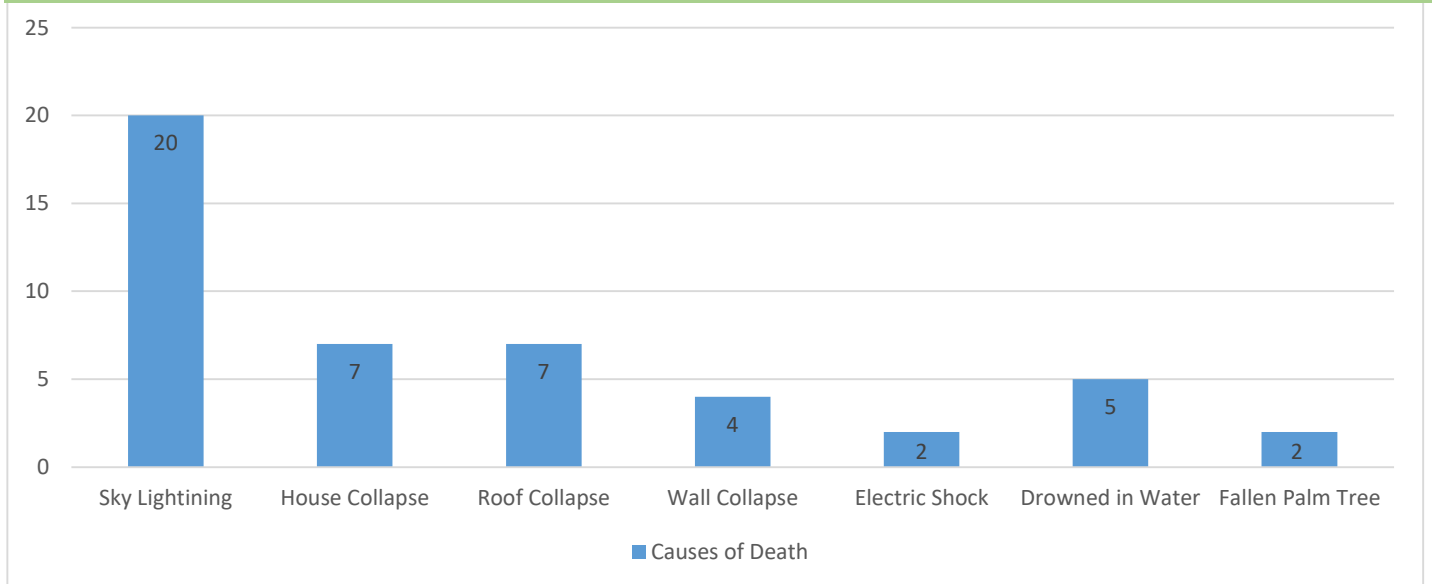


Cumulative Casualties – Deaths / Injuries (21-06-2024 to 27-08-2024)

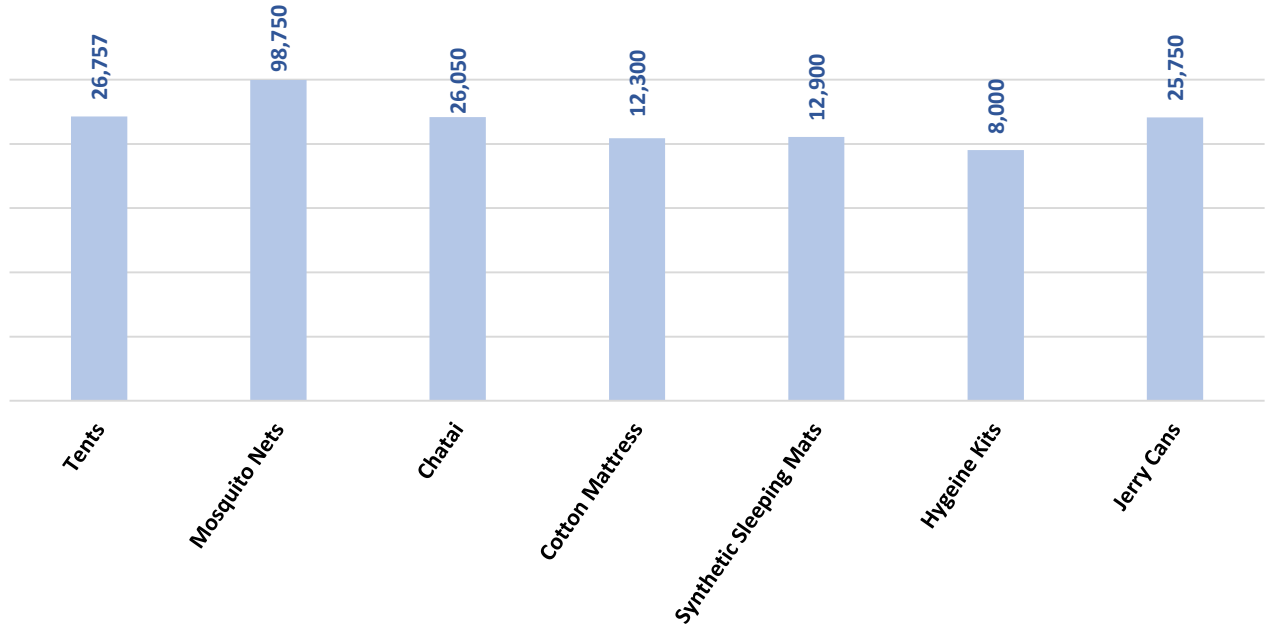
