Weather Update Dated 29-08-2024

Pakistan Meteorological Department has informed that the **deep depression** over Rann of Kutch, India has moved very slowly west / southwestwards and may emerge into northeast Arabian Sea along Sindh coast by late night / tomorrow morning. Due to this weather system strong monsoon currents are penetrating in Southern Sindh. Under its influence:

- **Widespread rain/ wind-thunderstorms** with **scattered heavy-very heavy to isolated extremely heavy falls** likely in **Tharparker, Badin, Thatta, Sujawal, Hyderabad, Tando Muhammad Khan, Tando Allahyar, Matiari, Umerkot, Mirpurkhas, Sanghar, Jamshoro, Dadu, Shaheed Benazirabad** districts, and Karachi division till **31st August** with occasional gaps.
- **Rain/ wind-thunderstorms** with **few heavy to isolated very heavy falls** likely in **Ghotki, Sukkur, Khairpur, Kashmore, Kambar Shahdadkot, Larkana, Naushahro Feroze, Jacobabad & Shikarpur** districts till **31st August** with occasional gaps.

Flood Forecasting Division of Pakistan Meteorological Department has also informed that **Flash Flooding** is expected in the areas along Kirthar ranges, **Jacobabad, Kambar Shahdadkot, Dadu & Jamshoro**. Urban Flooding is also expected in the metropolitan cities of Sindh. (**Bulletin No. C-076/24 dated: 29th Aug 2024**)

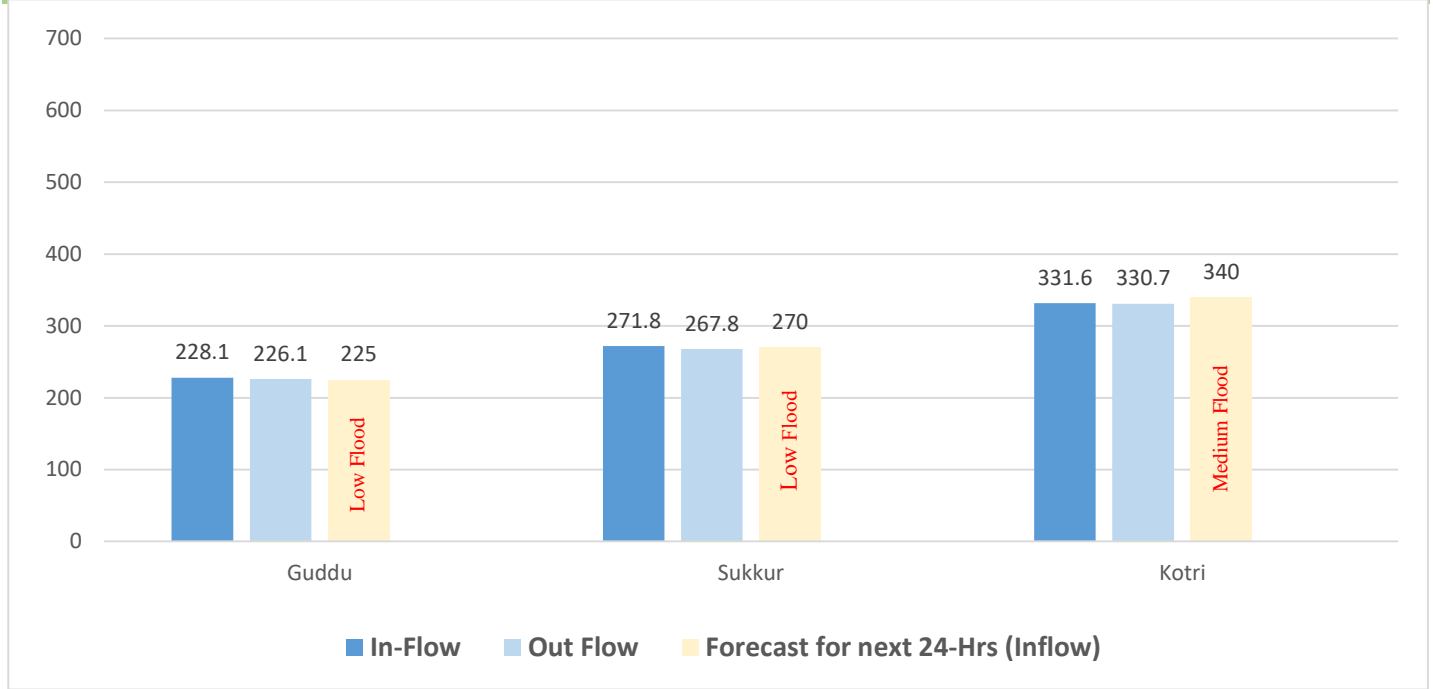

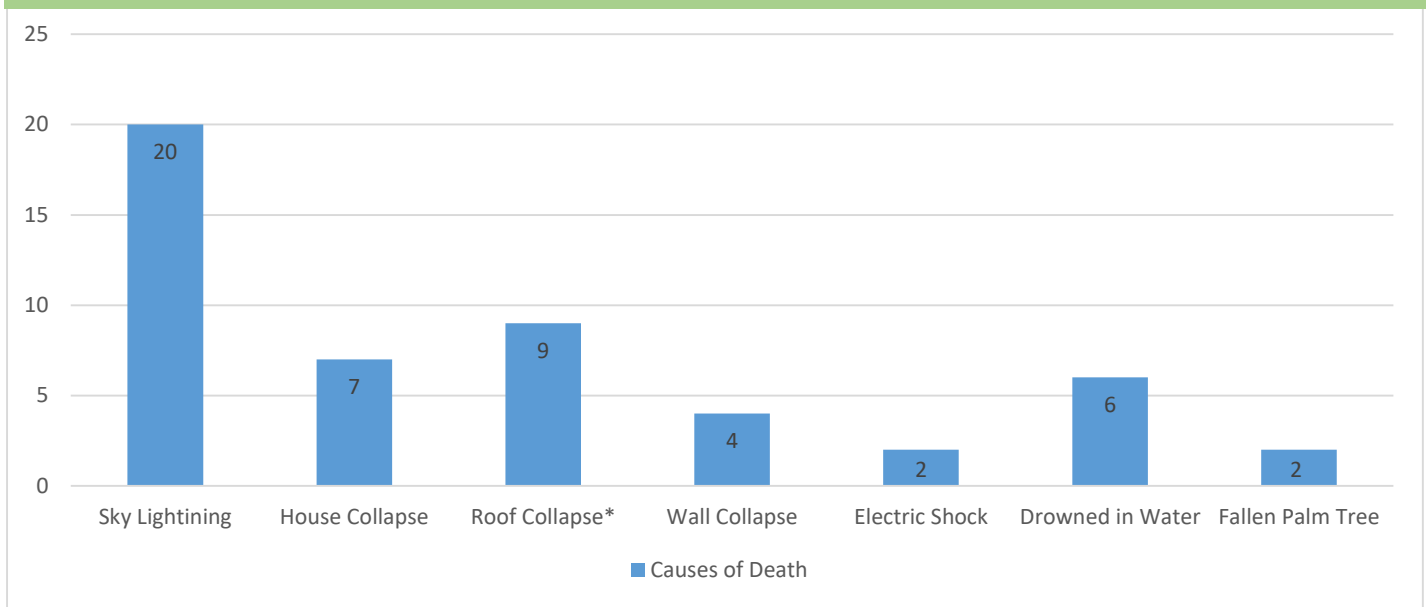
