Weather Update Dated 29-08-2024

Pakistan Meteorological Department has informed that the **deep depression** over Rann of Kutch, India has moved very slowly west / southwestwards and may emerge into northeast Arabian Sea along Sindh coast by late night / tomorrow morning. Due to this weather system strong monsoon currents are penetrating in Southern Sindh. Under its influence:

- Widespread rain/ wind-thunderstorms with scattered heavy-very heavy to isolated extremely heavy falls likely in Tharparker, Badin, Thatta, Sujawal, Hyderabad, Tando Muhammad Khan, Tando Allahyar, Matiari, Umerkot, Mirpurkhas, Sanghar, Jamshoro, Dadu, Shaheed Benazirabad districts, and Karachi division till 31st August with occasional gaps.
- Rain/ wind-thunderstorms with few heavy to isolated very heavy falls likely in Ghotki, Sukkur, Khairpur, Kashmore, Kambar Shahdadkot, Larkana, Naushahro Feroze, Jacobabad & Shikarpur districts till 31st August with occasional gaps.

Flood Forecasting Division of Pakistan Meteorological Department has also informed that **Flash Flooding** is expected in the areas along Kirthar ranges, **Jacobabad**, **Kambar Shahdadkot**, **Dadu & Jamshoro**. Urban Flooding is also expected in the metropolitan cities of Sindh. (**Bulletin No. C-076/24 dated: 29th Aug 2024**)
