Weather Update Dated 30-08-2024

Pakistan Meteorological Department has informed that the **deep depression** over Rann of Kutch, India has moved very slowly west / southwestwards and may emerge into northeast Arabian Sea along Sindh coast and intensify further into a **Cyclonic Storm** by today afternoon / evening. Due to this weather system strong monsoon currents are penetrating in Southern Sindh. Under its influence:

- **Widespread rain/ wind-thunderstorms with scattered heavy-very heavy to isolated extremely heavy falls** likely in Tharparker, Badin, Thatta, Sujawal, Hyderabad, Tando Muhammad Khan, Tando Allahyar, Matiari, Umerkot, Mirpurkhas, Sanghar, Jamshoro, Dadu, Shaheed Benazirabad districts, and Karachi division till **31st August** with occasional gaps.
- **Rain/ wind-thunderstorms with few heavy to isolated very heavy falls** likely in Sukkur, Kashmore, Kambar Shahdadkot, Larkano, Naushahro Feroze, Jacobabad, and Shikarpur districts till **31st August** with occasional gaps.
- Flood Forecasting Division of Pakistan Meteorological Department has also informed that Flash Flooding is expected in the areas along Kirthar ranges, **Jacobabad, Kambar Shahdadkot, Dadu & Jamshoro**. Urban Flooding is also expected in the metropolitan cities of Sindh.

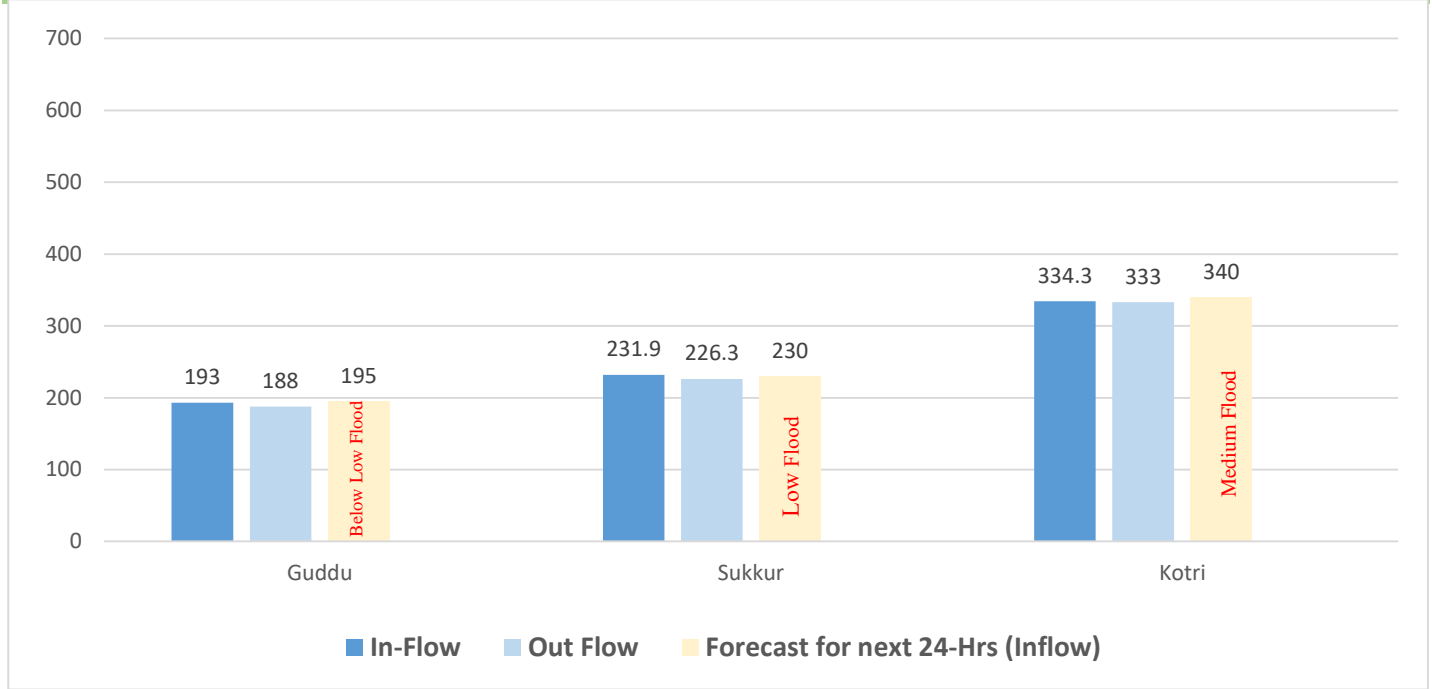

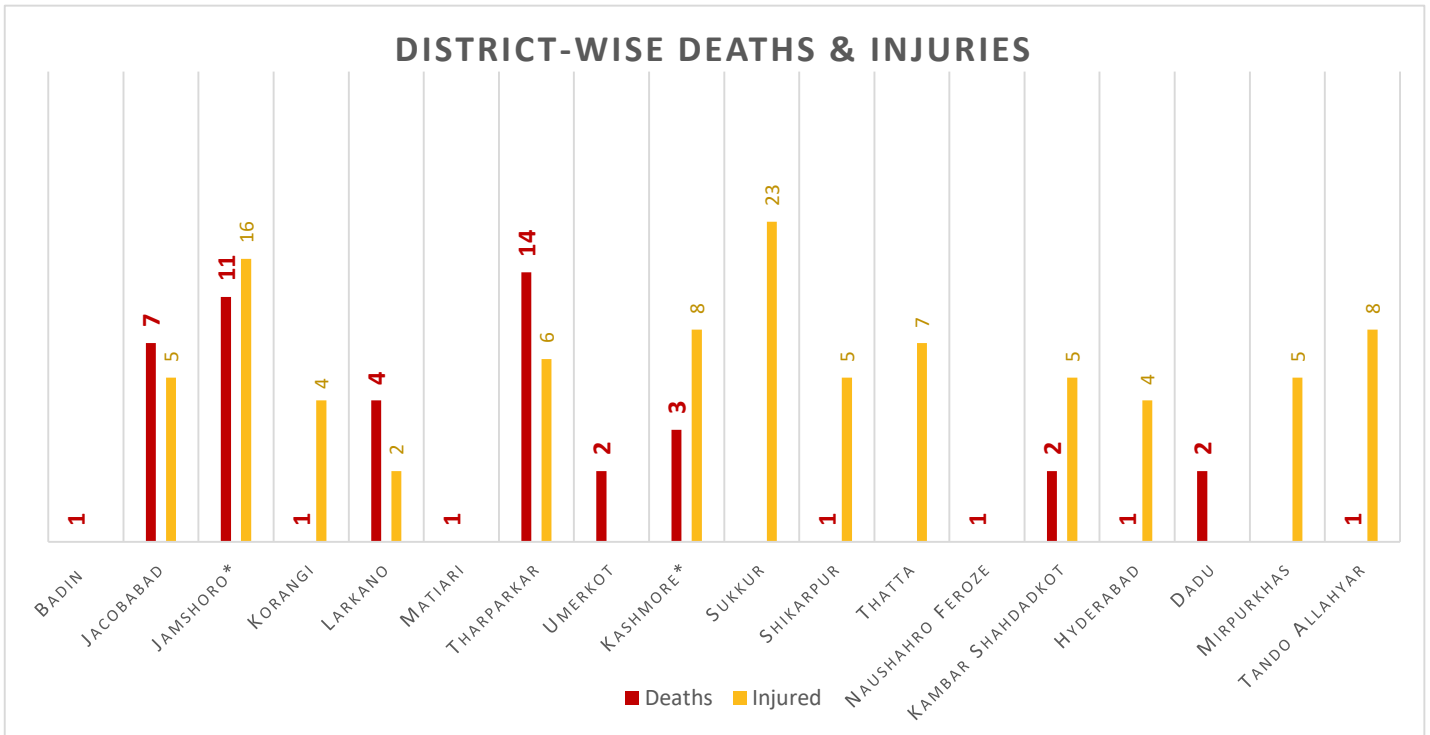

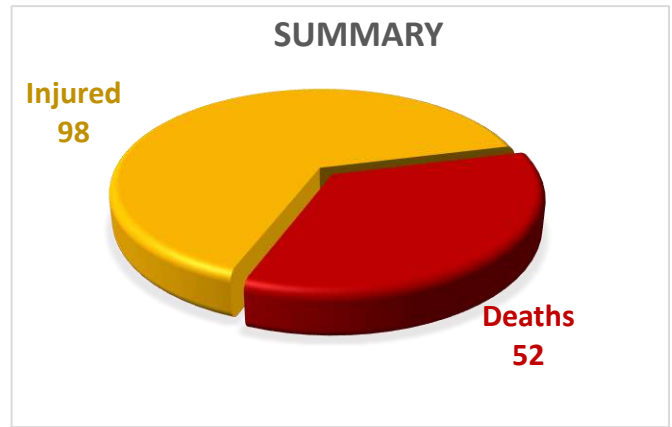
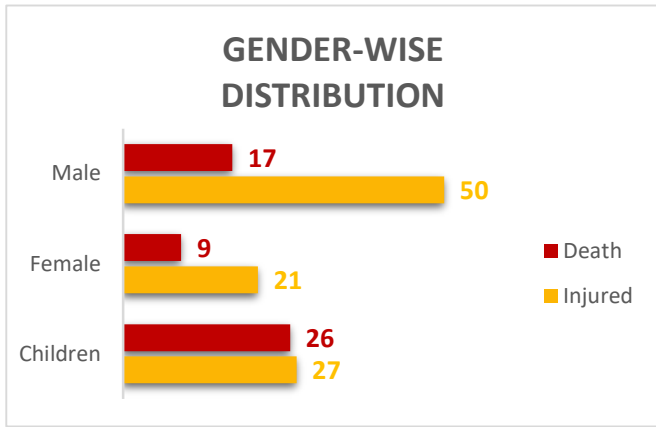
Cumulative Casualties – Deaths / Injuries (21-06-2024 to 30-08-2024)

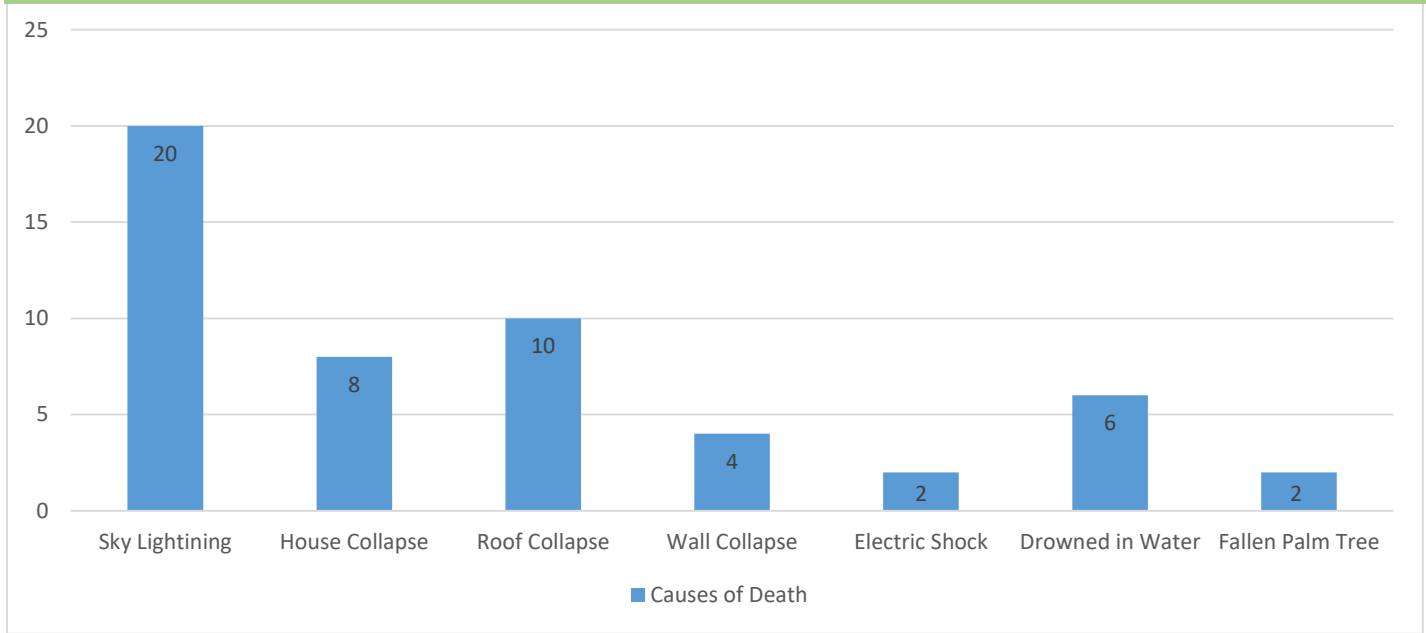

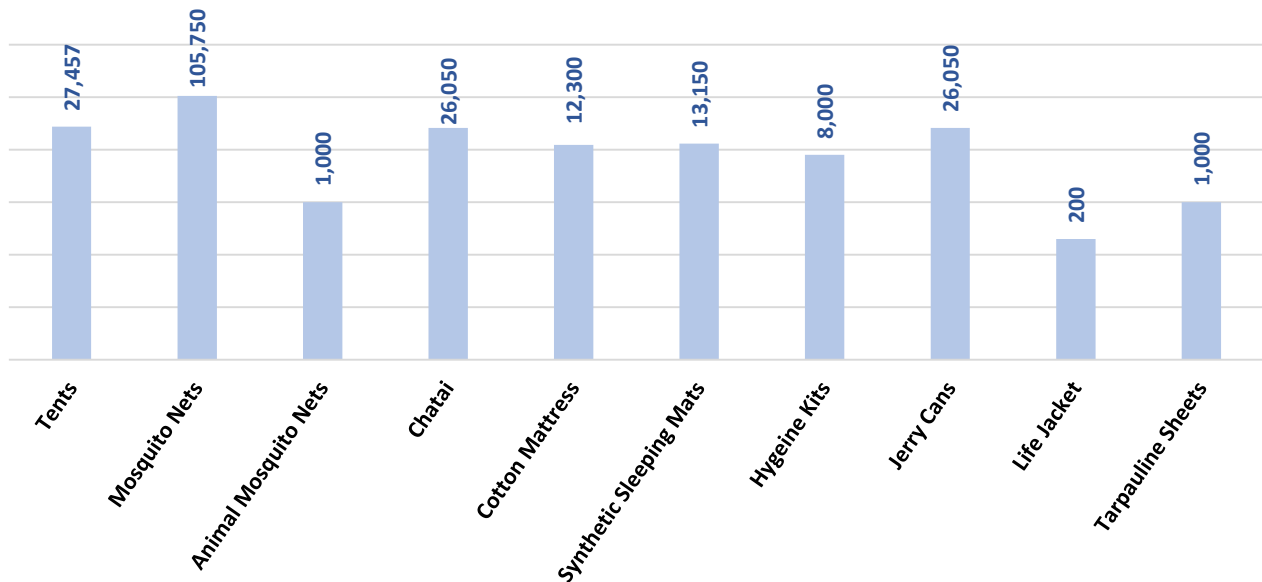
