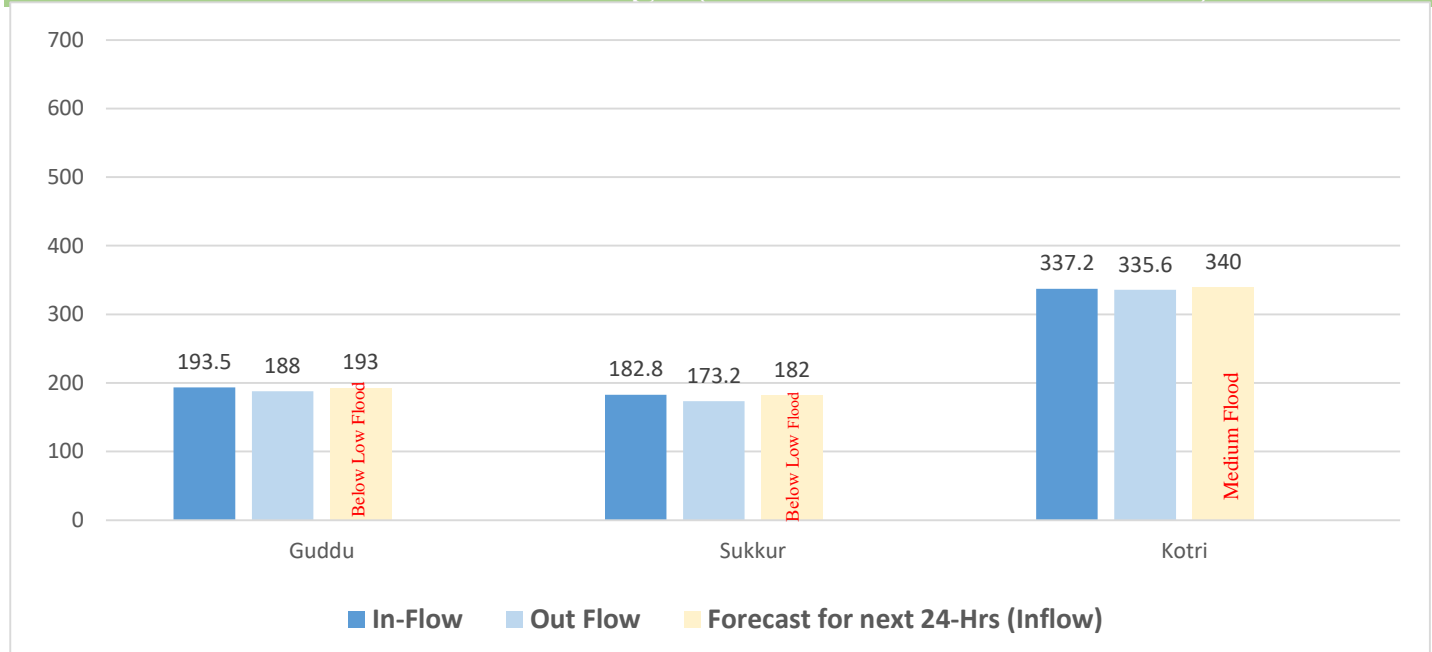
Weather Update Dated 31-08-2024

Pakistan Meteorological Department has informed that **Cyclonic Storm "ASNA"** over northeast of Arabian Sea kept moving westwards during past 06 hours and now lies at around 23.6 N, 65.5 E at a distance of about 230km southwest of Karachi, 180km of Ormara, and 300km southeast of Gwadar. Further, it is likely to continue move west-southwestwards. Due to this weather system moderate monsoon currents are penetrating in Southern and Western Sindh. Under its influence:

- Rain / showers of light / moderate intensity with occasional gusty winds likely in **Karachi, Sujawal, Thatta, Badin, Hyderabad, Jamshoro, Dadu, Kambar Shahdadkot districts** today while dry weather in rest of Sindh.

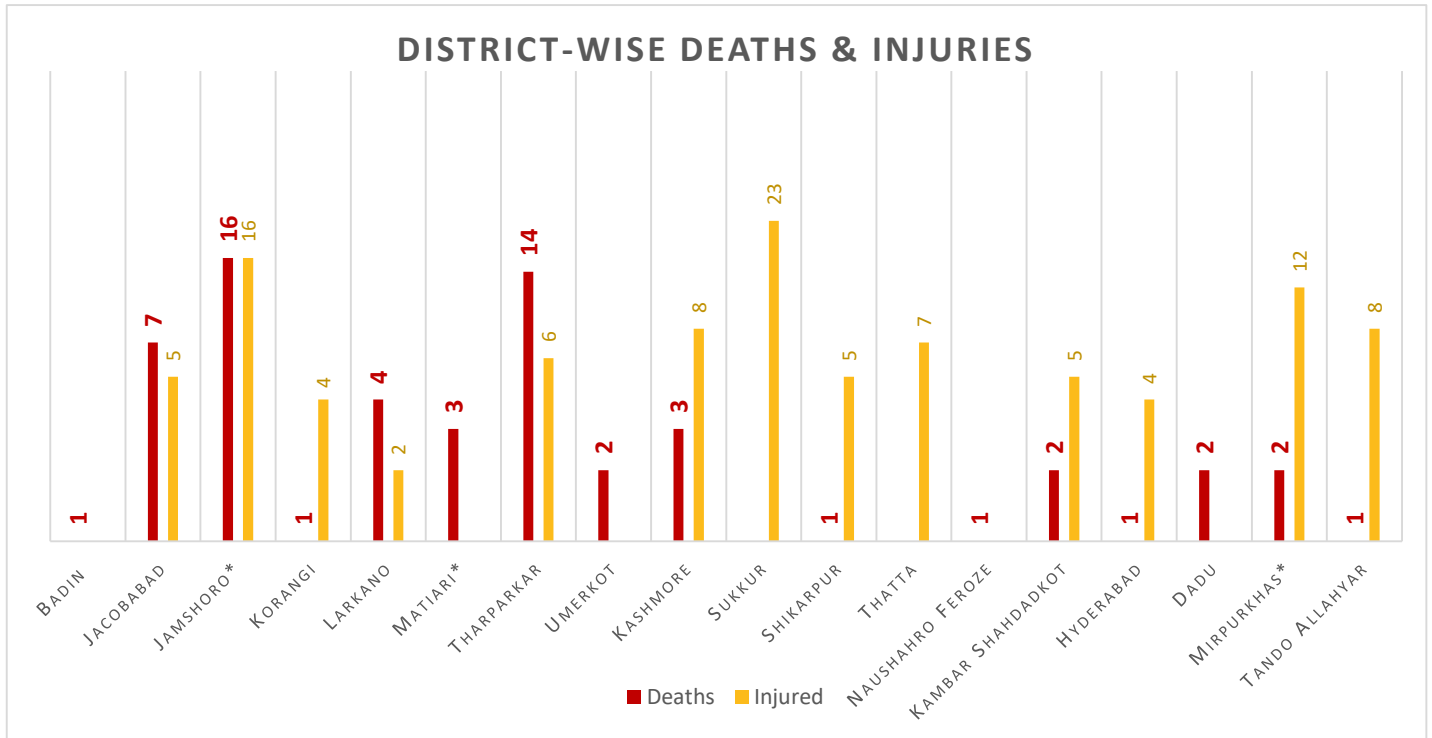

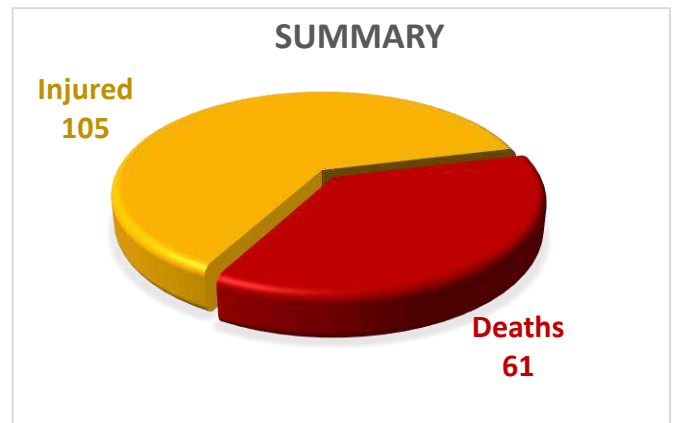
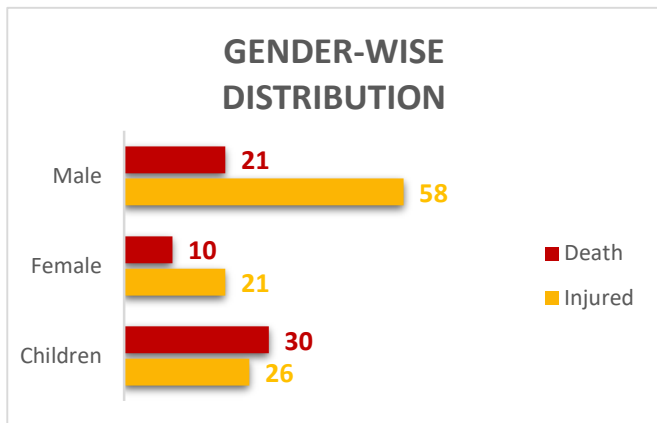
Cumulative Casualties – Deaths / Injuries (30-06-2024 to 31-08-2024)

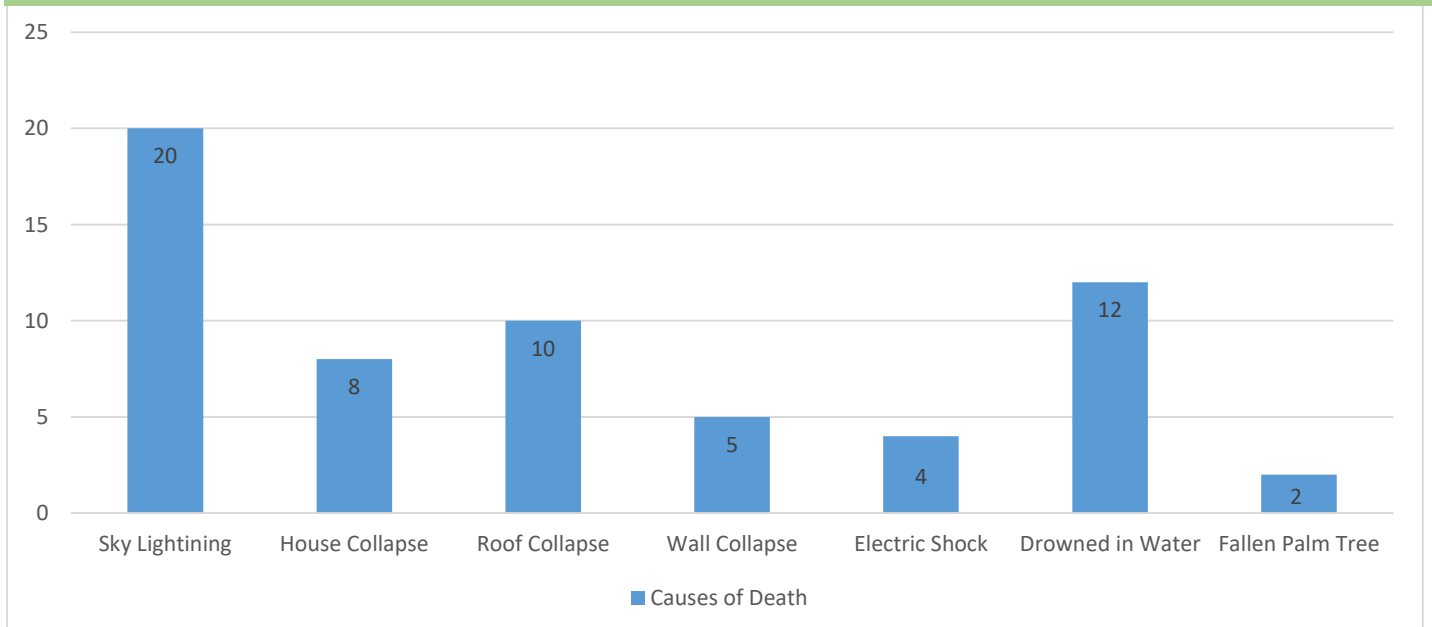

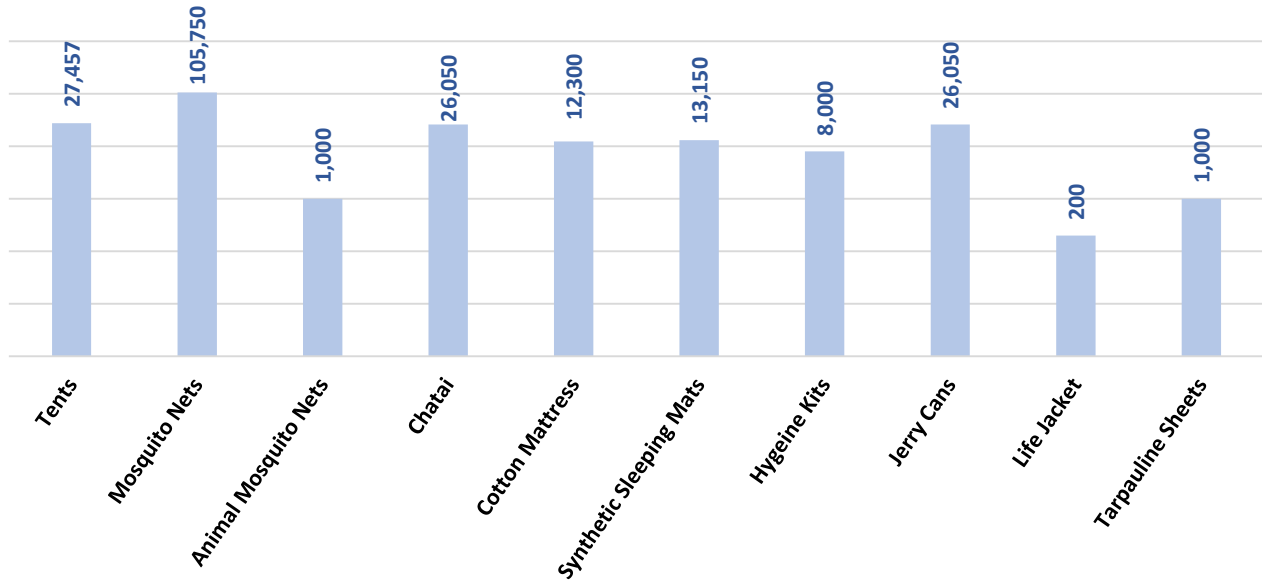
