Subject: **HOT AND HUMID WEATHER LIKELY TO PREVAIL IN MOST PARTS OF  
THE PROVINCE**

Pakistan Meteorological Department has informed that:

- Hot and humid weather likely to prevail over most parts of the province. However, Thunderstorm / light rain may occur at isolated places in Kambar Shahdadt and Dadu districts today.
- Weak monsoon currents are likely to penetrate in Southeastern parts of the province from tomorrow.
- Thunderstorm/light rain likely isolated places in Tharparker, Umerkot, and Mirpurkhas districts tomorrow.
- Guddu experienced **Medium level flood**, while Sukkur and Kotri Barrages are witnessing **Low-level flood**.

**Note:** River Indus at Guddu is expected to attain **very high level flood on 6<sup>th</sup> to 7<sup>th</sup> September**.


**RAINFALL OUTLOOK:**

**WARNING:**

- A fresh **EXCEPTIONALLY High Flood** Wave is expected in River Chenab at Marala and Downstream from today.
- **EXCEPTIONALLY High Flood level** will continue in river Sutlej at Ganda Singh Wala.
- River Chenab at Panjnad is expected to attain **Very High Flood level** from 4<sup>th</sup> to 5<sup>th</sup> September.
- River Indus at Guddu is expected to attain **High to Very High Flood level** from 6<sup>th</sup> to 7<sup>th</sup> September.
