## HOT AND HUMID WEATHER LIKELY TO PREVAIL IN MOST PARTS OF THE PROVINCE

Pakistan Meteorological Department has informed that:

- Hot and humid weather likely to prevail over most parts of the province. However, Thunderstorm / light rain may occur at isolated places in Kambar Shahdadkot and Dadu districts today.
- Weak monsoon currents are likely to penetrate in Southeastern parts of the province from tomorrow.
- Thunderstorm/light rain likely isolated places in Tharparker, Umerkot, and Mirpurkhas districts tomorrow.
- Guddu experienced **Medium level flood**, while Sukkur and Kotri Barrages are witnessing **Low-level** flood.

Note: River Indus at Guddu is expected to attain very high level flood on 6th to 7th September.

- River Indus at Guddu is expected to attain High to Very High Flood level from 6<sup>th</sup> to 7<sup>th</sup> September.
