Subject: **HOT AND HUMID WEATHER LIKELY TO PREVAIL IN MOST PARTS OF
THE PROVINCE**

Pakistan Meteorological Department has informed that:

- Hot and humid weather is likely to prevail over most parts of the province.
- Weak monsoon currents are likely to penetrate in Southeastern parts of the province from today.
- Thunderstorm/light rain likely isolated places in Tharparker, Umerkot, and Mirpurkhas districts today.
- Guddu, Sukkur and Kotri Barrages are witnessing **Low-level** flood.

Note: River Indus at Guddu is expected to attain **very high level flood on 6th to 7th September.**

RIVERS' CATCHMENTS' (05th SEP-25 TO 11th SEP-25)**


RAINFALL OUTLOOK:

- **EXCEPTIONALLY High Flood level** will continue in river Sutlej at Ganda Singh Wala.
- River Chenab at Panjnad is expected to attain **High to Very High Flood level** on 5th September.
- River Indus at Guddu is expected to attain **High to Very High Flood level** on 7th September.
