

#### RAIN-WIND / THUNDERSTORM SHOWER IN VARIOUS DISTRICTS OF SINDH

Pakistan Meteorological Department has informed that a low pressure area is currently located over west Madhya Pradesh (India) and is likely to move west-northwest wards reach Rajasthan and adjoining Sindh by tomorrow. Due to this system strong monsoon currents likely to penetrate in eastern parts of the province from tomorrow. Under its influence:

- Widespread Rain-Wind/Thunderstorm shower with scattered heavy to very heavy falls are expected in Tharparker, Umerkot, Mirpurkhas, Sanghar, Khairpur, Shaheed Benazirabad, Matiari, Tando Muhammad Khan, Tando Allahyar, Hyderabad, Thatta, Badin, Sujawal, Jamshoro districts from 06<sup>th</sup> (evening/night) to 10<sup>th</sup> September with occasional gaps.
- While widespread Rain-Wind/Thunderstorm shower with scattered moderate to isolated heavy falls are likely in Dadu, Larkano, Shikarpur, Kashmore, Sukkur, Jacobabad, Ghotki districts from 7th to 10th September with occasional gaps.
- Rain-Wind/Thunderstorm shower with a few moderate to isolated heavy falls are likely in Karachi division from evening 7<sup>th</sup> to 11<sup>th</sup> September with occasional gaps.
- Guddu, Sukkur and Kotri Barrages are witnessing Low-level flood.

**Note:** River Indus at Guddu is expected to attain very high level flood on 7<sup>th</sup> September.

- Heavy downpour/windstorm and lightning may affect daily routines, urban flooding, water logging in low lying areas in Mirpurkhas, Shaheed Benazirabad, Tharparkar, Khairpur, Sukkur, Larkano, Thatta, Badin, Sujawal, Hyderabad, and Karachi and may damage weak structures like roof/wall of Kacha houses, electric poles, bill boards, vehicles and solar panels etc. during the forecast period.
- Farmers are advised to manage their activities keeping in view the weather forecast.
- Moreover, Pakistan Meteorological Department has also issued Quantitative Flood Forecast of Gauging Stations (in thousands of cusecs) at 11:40 hours (PST) which is reproduced as under:
