## RAIN-WIND / THUNDERSHOWER IS EXPECTED IN SINDH PROVINCE

Pakistan Meteorological Department has informed that yesterday's well-marked low pressure intensified into Depression and now lies over Southwest Rajasthan (India) and adjoining Sindh. Due to this system strong monsoon currents continues to penetrate in the province. Under its influence:

- Widespread Rain-Wind/Thundershower with scattered heavy to very heavy falls are expected in, Umerkot, Mirpurkhas, Sanghar, Khairpur, Shaheed Benazirabad, Dadu, Matiari, Tando Muhammad Khan, Tando Allahyar, Hyderabad, Thatta, Badin, Sujawal, Jamshoro districts till 11th September with occasional gaps.
- Widespread Rain-Wind/Thundershower with scattered moderate to isolated heavy falls are likely in Larkano, Shikarpur, Kashmore, Sukkur, Jacobabad, Ghotki districts till 11th September with occasional
- Rain-Wind/Thundershower with a few moderate to isolated heavy falls/very heavy falls are likely in Karachi division from today evening to 11<sup>th</sup> September with occasional gaps.
- Guddu experienced Medium level flood, while Sukkur and Kotri Barrages are witnessing Low-level flood.

Note: River Indus at Guddu is expected to attain very high level flood on 8th to 9th September.
