HOT AND HUMID WEATHER IS LIKELY TO PREVAIL OVER MOST PARTS OF THE PROVINCE

Pakistan Meteorological Department has informed that Hot and Humid weather is likely to prevail over most parts of the province. However, partly cloudy with chances of isolated drizzle may occur in coastal areas.
