HOT AND HUMID WEATHER LIKELY IN MOST PARTS OF THE PROVINCE

Pakistan Meteorological Department has informed that:

- Hot and humid weather likely in most parts of the province.
- Rain / thunderstorm is expected at isolated places in Jacobabad, Kashmore, Ghotki, Khairpur, Kamber Shahdadkot, Sanghar, Umerkot, and Tharparkar districts today.
- Guddu Barrage is experiencing Medium-level flow, while Sukkur and Kotri Barrages are witnessing Low-level flood.

Note: River Indus at Guddu and Sukkur is expected to attain very high flood on 4th to 5th September.

SUBJECT: WEEKLY SIGNIFICANT WEATHER OUTLOOK FOR RIVERS' CATCHMENTS' (30th AUG-25 TO 05th SEP-25)

RAINFALL OUTLOOK:

ALERT:

Under the influence of monsoon low over north Madhya Pradesh heavy to very heavy rainfall with extremely heavy fall is expected over the upper catchments of river Sutlej, Bias and Ravi during 2nd to 3rd September.

In view of the latest hydrometeorological conditions, owing to water releases from Indian dams during the period river flows in the eastern rivers are likely to increase **EXCEPTIONALLY**.

FLOOD SITUATION IN MAJOR RIVERS:

WARNING:

- EXCEPTIONALLY High Flood level will continue in river Sutlej at Ganda Singh Wala.
- River Chenab at Trimmu is expected to attain EXCEPTIONALLY High Flood level during next 24-hours.
- River Chenab at Panjnad is expected to attain Very High flood level on 3rd September.
- > River Indus at Guddu is expected to attain very high flood on 5th September.
