Subject: LIGHT TO MODERATE RAINFALL IS EXPECTED IN VARIOUS DISTRICTS OF SINDH

Pakistan Meteorological Department has informed that yesterday's depression over southwest Sindh moved nearly westwards and now lying 60km west of Karachi. It is likely to move further westwards and gradually weaken into well-marked low pressure area in next couple of hours. Under its influence:

- Light to moderate rainfalls are expected in Karachi division, Jamshoro, Thatta, and Sujawal districts today.
- Hot and humid weather is expected in most parts of the province.

WARNING:

- River Indus at Guddu is expected to attain **Very High Flood Level** during next 24 hours.
- River Indus at Sukkur is expected to attain **High Flood Level** after 24 hours.
