

LIGHT-RAIN / DRIZZLE IS EXPECTED IN VARIOUS DISTRICTS OF SINDH Subject:

Pakistan Meteorological Department has informed that yesterday's depression over coastal Balochistan weakened into a Well-marked low pressure area over northwest Arabian Sea. It is likely to move further westwards and gradually weaken into low pressure area in the same region in next couple of hours. Under its influence:

- Light-rain / Drizzle are expected in Karachi division, Jamshoro, Hyderabad, Mirpurkhas, Sanghar, Thatta, and Sujawal districts today.
- Hot and humid weather is expected elsewhere in the province.

WARNING:

- River Indus at Guddu is expected to attain Very High Flood Level during next 24 hours.
- River Indus at Sukkur is expected to attain **High Flood Level** after 24 hours.
