**Subject: LIGHT-RAIN / DRIZZLE IS EXPECTED IN VARIOUS DISTRICTS OF SINDH**  
Pakistan Meteorological Department has informed that yesterday's depression over coastal Balochistan weakened into a **Well-marked low pressure area** over northwest Arabian Sea. It is likely to move further westwards and gradually weaken into low pressure area in the same region in next couple of hours. Under its influence:

- Light-rain / Drizzle are expected in Karachi division, Jamshoro, Hyderabad, Mirpurkhas, Sanghar, Thatta, and Sujawal districts today.
- Hot and humid weather is expected elsewhere in the province.

**WARNING:**

- River Indus at Guddu is expected to attain **Very High Flood Level** during next 24 hours.
- River Indus at Sukkur is expected to attain **High Flood Level** after 24 hours.
