HOT AND HUMID WEATHER CONDITIONS ARE LIKELY TO PREVAIL OVER MOST PARTS OF THE PROVINCE

Pakistan Meteorological Department has informed that:

- Hot & humid weather conditions are likely to prevail over most parts of the province.
- Partly cloudy weather with chances of drizzle/light rain are expected in Jamshoro, Badin, Thatta, Sujawal, Tharparkar districts and Karachi division during next 24 hours.
- Guddu Sukkur and Kotri Barrages are experiencing normal flow.
- 2. Moreover, Pakistan Meteorological Department has also issued **Quantitative Flood Forecast of Gauging Stations** (in thousands of cusecs) which is reproduced as under:
