Pakistan Meteorological Department has informed that:

- Weak monsoon currents likely to penetrate into Southeastern parts of Sindh.
- Partly cloudy weather with chances of drizzle/light rain are expected in Sukkur, Ghotki, Kashmore, Dadu, Jamshoro, Hyderabad, Tando Muhammad Khan, Mirpurkhas, Umerkot, Badin, Thatta, Sujawal, Tharparker districts during next 24hours.
- Guddu Barrage experiencing a low-level flood, whereas Sukkur and Kotri Barrages are witnessing normal water flow.
- 2. Moreover, Pakistan Meteorological Department has also issued **Quantitative Flood Forecast of Gauging Stations** (in thousands of cusecs) which is reproduced as under:
