Pakistan Meteorological Department has informed that:

- Weak monsoon currents likely to penetrate into Eastern parts of Sindh.
- Partly cloudy to cloudy with chances of drizzle/light rain are expected in Badin, Thatta, Sujawal, Mirpurkhas, Sanghar, Jamshoro, Ghotki, Shikarpur. While, light to moderate rainfall in Umerkot, Tharparker districts during next 24 hours.
- Guddu, Sukkur and Kotri Barrages are witnessing normal water flow.
- 2. Moreover, Pakistan Meteorological Department has also issued **Quantitative Flood Forecast of Gauging Stations** (in thousands of cusecs) which is reproduced as under:
