Subject: **WEAK MONSOON CURRENTS ARE PENETRATING INTO EASTERN PARTS  
OF SINDH**

Pakistan Meteorological Department has informed that weak monsoon currents are penetrating into Eastern parts of the province, which become stronger and spread over the province from **18<sup>th</sup> August**. Under its influence.

- Partly cloudy and humid conditions are likely over most parts of the province **today** with chances of Thunderstorm/rain of light to moderate intensity likely in Tharparker, Umerkot, Mirpurkhas, however chances of light rain/drizzle in Badin, Sanghar, Thatta, Sujawal, Jamshoro, Hyderabad, Tando Allahyar, Tando Muhammad Khan, Matiari, Shaheed Benazirabad and Khairpur districts **today**.
- Thunderstorm/rain with few moderate to isolated heavy falls likely in Tharparker, Umerkot, Mirpurkhas, Badin, Tando Muhammad Khan, while light rain may occur in Sukkur, Ghotki, Hyderabad, Sanghar, Tando Allahyar, Matiari, Thatta, Khairpur districts **tomorrow**.
- Thunderstorm/rain with few moderate to isolated heavy falls likely in Ghotki, Sukkur, Kashmore, Naushahro faroze, Dadu, Mirpurkhas, Sanghar, Khairpur, Shaheed Benazirabad, Hyderabad, Jamshoro, Tando Muhammad Khan, Tando Allahyar, Umerkot, Thatta, Sujawal, Badin, Matiari and Tharparker districts, however Thunderstorm/rain light to moderate intensity in Shikarpur, Jacobabad, Larkana and Kamber Shahadadkot districts and Karachi division on **18<sup>th</sup> August**.
- Guddu, Sukkur and Kotri Barrages are witnessing normal water flow.
