Subject: **STRONG MONSOON CURRENTS ARE CONTINUOUSLY PENETRATING
IN MOST PARTS OF THE PROVINCE**

Pakistan Meteorological Department has informed that Strong monsoon currents are continuously penetrating in most parts of the province. Under its influence:

- Thunderstorm/rain with a few moderate to isolated heavy falls likely in Ghotki, Khairpur, Sanghar, Mirpurkhas, Umerkot, Tharparkar, Badin, Thatta, Sujawal, Hyderabad, Tando Muhammad Khan, Tando Allahyar, Matiari, Sukkur, Shikarpur, Shaheed Benazirabad, Naushahro Feroze, Jacobabad, Kashmore, Larkano, Dadu, Kambar Shahdadt districts from tonight i.e. 18th July 2025 till Sunday i.e. 20th July 2025 with occasionally gaps, while light rain may occur in Jamshoro district and Karachi division during Saturday/Sunday.

2. Moreover, Pakistan Meteorological Department has also issued **Quantitative Flood Forecast of Gauging Stations** (in thousands of cusecs) which is reproduced as under:
