Subject: **TORRENTIAL RAINS PREDICTED IN SINDH IN NEXT COUPLE OF DAYS**

Pakistan Meteorological Department has informed that **Strong Monsoon currents** from Arabian Sea and Bay of Bengal are continuously penetrating the country especially the Southern parts. Under its influence:

- Widespread rain-wind/Thundershower with few moderate to **(with scattered heavy falls at times very heavy)** is expected in Mithi, Tharparker, Umerkot, Mirpurkhas, Hyderabad, Shaheed Benazirabad, Karachi, Thatta, Badin, Sujawal, Tando Allahyar, Tando Muhammad Khan, Sanghar, Jamshoro, while scattered places in Sukkur, Larkano, Khairpur, and Jacobabad from **19th to 22nd August** with occasional gaps.

Possible Impacts & advises:

- Torrential rains may cause urban flood in low lying areas of Sindh (Karachi, Thatta, Badin, Sujawal, Tharparkar, Umerkot, Mirpurkhas, Hyderabad, Shaheed Benazirabad, Tando Allahyar, Tando Muhammad Khan, Sanghar, Jamshoro) from 19th to 22nd August.
- Heavy falls/windstorm and lightning may damage weak structures like roof/wall of Kacha houses, electric poles, bill boards, vehicles and solar panels etc. during the forecast period.
- Public, Travelers and tourists are advised to avoid unusual exposure to vulnerable areas to avoid any untoward situation and keep updated about latest weather conditions.

2. Keeping in view above, it is requested that all concerned Deputy Commissioners / Chairman DDMA's and other relevant authorities/ stakeholders may take all necessary mitigation measures.

Note: All concerned Authorities/Chairmen DDMA's are advised to remain "ALERT" round the clock and take necessary measures to avoid any untoward situation.

Torrential Rains Predicted in Sindh and Parts of Balochistan in next couple of days

According to Met office strong monsoon currents from Arabian Sea and Bay of Bengal are continuously penetrating the country especially the southern parts. Under the influence of these meteorological conditions.

Sindh:

Widespread rain-wind/thundershower (with scattered heavyfalls at times very heavy) is expected in Mithi, Tharparker, Umer Kot, Mirpurkhas, Hyderabad, Shaheed Benazirabad, Karachi, Thatta, Badin, Sajawal, Tando Allayar, Tando Muhammad Khan, Sanghar, Jamshoro, while at scattered places in Sukkur, Larkana, Khairpur and Jacobabad from **19th to 22nd August** with occasional gaps.

Balochistan:

Rain-wind/thundershower (with scattered heavyfalls) is expected in Barkhan, Musakhel, Loralai, Sibbi, Zhob, Qilla Saifullah, Khuzdar, Lasbella, Awaran, Kech, Gawadar and Panjgur from **19th to 22nd August** with occasional gaps.

Subdued rain-wind/thundershower is expected at isolated places in Islamabad, Kashmir, Gilgit-Baltistan, upper Punjab (Rawalpindi, Attock, Murree/Galliyat, Chakwal, Jhelum, Gujrat, Gujranwala, Sialkot, Lahore, Dera Ghazi Khan, Multan and Rajanpur), and Khyber-Pakhtunkhwa (Dir, Chitral, Swat, Kohistan, Shangla, Battagram, Mansehra, Abbottabad, Haripur, Buner, Malakand, Bajaur, Mohmand, Peshawar, Charsadda, Nowshera, Mardan, Swabi,) from **19th to 22nd August.**

Possible Impacts and advises:

- **Torrential rains may cause urban flood in low lying areas of Sindh (Karachi, Thatta, Badin, Sajawal, Tharparker, Umer Kot, Mirpurkhas, Hyderabad, Shaheed Benazirabad, Tando Allayar, Tando Muhammad Khan, Sanghar, Jamshoro) from 19th to 22nd August.**
- **Torrential rains may generate flash floods in north/southeastern parts of Balochistan from 19th to 22nd August.**
- **Heavyfalls/windstorm and lightning may damage weak structures like roof/wall of Kacha houses, electric poles, bill boards, vehicles and solar panels etc during the forecast period.**
- **Public, Travelers and tourists are advised to avoid unusual exposure to vulnerable areas to avoid any untoward situation and keep updated about latest weather conditions.**

ویدرلرٹ

آنے والے دنوں میں سندھ اور بلوچستان کے بیشتر علاقوں میں وقفے وقفے سے بارشوں کی پیش گوئی

محکمہ موسمیات کے مطابق بحیرہ عرب اور خلیج بنگال سے شدید مون سون ہوائیں ملک کے بیشتر علاقوں (خصوصاً جنوبی علاقوں) میں مسلسل داخل ہو رہی ہیں۔ جس کے زیر اثر:

سندھ: 19 سے 22 اگست کے دوران: مٹی، تھرپاکر، عمرکوٹ، میرپور خاص، حیدر آباد، شہید بینظیر آباد، کراچی، ٹھٹھہ، بدین، سہاول، ٹنڈوالہار، ٹنڈو محمد خان، ساگھڑ، جامشورو میں تیز ہواؤں اور گرج چمک کے ساتھ وقفے وقفے سے اکثر مقامات پر بارش اور کہیں کہیں موسلا دھار / شدید موسلا دھار بارش کا امکان۔ اس دوران سکھر، لاڑکانہ، خیرپور اور جیکب آباد میں کہیں کہیں تیز ہواؤں اور گرج چمک کے ساتھ بارش کا بھی امکان۔

بلوچستان: 19 سے 22 اگست کے دوران: بارکھان، موسیٰ خیل، لورالائی، سبی، ثوب، قلعہ سیف اللہ، خضدار، لسبیلہ، آواران، کچ، گواد اور پنجگور میں تیز ہواؤں اور گرج چمک کے ساتھ وقفے وقفے سے بارش اور کہیں کہیں موسلا دھار بارش کا بھی امکان۔

19 سے 21 اگست کے دوران: اسلام آباد، کشمیر، گلگت بلتستان، بالائی پنجاب (راولپنڈی، اٹک، مری، گلیات، پکوال، بہلم، گجرات، گوجرانوالہ، سیالکوٹ، لاہور، ڈیرہ غازی خان، ملتان اور راجن پور) اور خیبر پختونخوا (دیر، چترال، سوات، کوہستان، شانگلہ، بگرام، مانسہرہ، ایبٹ آباد، ہری پور، بونیر، مالاکنڈ، باجوڑ، مہمند، پشاور، چارسدہ، نوشہرہ، مردان اور صوابی) میں تیز ہواؤں اور گرج چمک کے ساتھ چند مقامات پر بارش کا امکان۔

محکمہ اثرات اور احتیاطی تدابیر:

- 19 سے 22 اگست کے دوران شدید موسلا دھار بارشوں کے باعث سندھ (کراچی، ٹھٹھہ، بدین، سہاول، تھرپاکر، عمرکوٹ، میرپور خاص، حیدر آباد، شہید بینظیر آباد، ٹنڈوالہار، ٹنڈو محمد خان، ساگھڑ اور جامشورو) کے نشیبی علاقے زیر آب آنے کا خدشہ۔
- 19 سے 22 اگست کے دوران شمال / جنوب مشرقی بلوچستان کے علاقوں کے ندی نالوں میں طغیانی کا خطرہ۔ عوام الناس کو احتیاط کی ہدایت۔
- شدید بارشوں / آندھی / جھکڑ چلنے اور گرج چمک کے باعث روزمرہ کے معمولات متاثر ہونے، کمزور انفراسٹرکچر (کچے گھر / دیواریں، بجلی کے کیمپے، بل بورڈز، گاڑیوں سولر بینل وغیرہ) کو نقصان کا اندیشہ۔
- مسافروں اور سیاح حضرات سفر کے دوران زیادہ محتاط رہیں اور موسمی حالات کے مطابق اپنے سفر کا انتظام کریں اور بارشوں کے دوران کسی بھی ناخوشگوار صورتحال سے بچنے کے لیے موسم کے بارے میں آگاہی حاصل کریں۔
