

STRONG MONSOON CURRENTS ARE PENETRATING INTO MOST PARTS OF THE PROVINCE

Pakistan Meteorological Department has informed that Strong Monsoon currents are **penetrating** into most parts of the province. Under its influence:

- Widespread rain/Thunderstorm with scattered moderate to few heavy/very heavy falls likely in Hyderabad, Jamshoro, Tando Muhammad Khan, Tando Allahyar, Umerkot, Thatta, Sujawal, Badin, Matiari, Tharparker, Mirpurkhas, Sanghar districts and Karachi division till 23rd August with occasional gaps.
- Widespread rain / Thunderstorm with few moderate to isolated heavy falls likely in Jacobabad, Shikarpur, Larkano, Kambar Shahdadkot, Ghotki, Sukkur, Kashmore, Naushahro Feroze, Dadu, Khairpur, Shaheed Benazirabad till 23rd August with occasional gaps.
- Guddu Barrage experiencing Medium-level flood, Sukkur Barrage a low-level flood and Kotri Barrages witnessing normal water flow.

Possible Impacts & advises:

- Heavy downpour/windstorm and lightning may affect daily routines, urban flooding, water logging in low lying areas and may damage weak structures like roof/wall of Kacha houses, electric poles, bill boards, vehicles and solar panels etc. during the forecast period.
- Farmers are advised to manage their activities keeping in view the weather forecast. Also avoid unnecessary open exposure during Thunderstorm and keep livestock in safe shelters to prevent lightning strike.
- 2. Moreover, Pakistan Meteorological Department has also issued Quantitative Flood Forecast of Gauging Stations (in thousands of cusecs) which is reproduced as under:
