Subject: **STRONG MONSOON CURRENTS ARE CONTINUOUSLY PENETRATING
INTO MOST PARTS OF THE PROVINCE**

Pakistan Meteorological Department has informed that **Strong Monsoon currents are continuously penetrating** into most parts of the province. Under its influence:

- Widespread rain/Thunderstorm with scattered moderate to few **heavy falls** likely in Hyderabad, Jamshoro, Tando Muhammad Khan, Tando Allahyar, Umerkot, Thatta, Sujawal, Badin, Matiari, Tharparkar, Mirpurkhas, Sanghar districts and Karachi division today.
- Widespread rain / Thunderstorm with few moderate to isolated heavy falls likely in Larkana, Sukkur, Naushahro Feroze, Dadu, Khairpur, Shaheed Benazirabad today.
- Guddu Barrage experiencing Medium-level flood, Sukkur Barrage a low-level flood and Kotri Barrages witnessing normal water flow.

Possible Impacts & advises:

- Heavy downpour/windstorm and lightning may affect daily routines, urban flooding, water logging in low lying areas and may damage weak structures like roof/wall of Kacha houses, electric poles, bill boards, vehicles and solar panels etc. during the forecast period.
- Farmers are advised to manage their activities keeping in view the weather forecast. Also avoid unnecessary open exposure during Thunderstorm and keep livestock in safe shelters to prevent lightning strike.

2. Moreover, Pakistan Meteorological Department has also issued **Quantitative Flood Forecast of Gauging Stations** (in thousands of cusecs) which is reproduced as under:
