Subject: **MONSOON CURRENTS ARE CONTINUOUSLY PENETRATING INTO MOST PARTS OF THE PROVINCE**

Pakistan Meteorological Department has informed that **Monsoon currents are continuously penetrating** into most parts of the province. Under its influence:

- Rain / Thunderstorm likely in Hyderabad, Jamshoro, Tando Muhammad Khan, Tando Allahyar, Umerkot, Thatta, Sujawal, Badin, Matiari, Tharparkar, Mirpurkhas, and Sanghar districts today.
- Light rain / drizzle may occur in Karachi division today.
- Guddu Barrage experiencing Medium-level flood, Sukkur Barrage a low-level flood and Kotri Barrages witnessing normal water flow.

2. Moreover, Pakistan Meteorological Department has also issued **Quantitative Flood Forecast of Gauging Stations** (in thousands of cusecs) which is reproduced as under:
