Subject: **MONSOON CURRENTS ARE PENETRATING INTO EASTERN PARTS OF THE PROVINCE**

Pakistan Meteorological Department has informed that **Monsoon currents are penetrating** into Eastern parts of the province. Under its influence:

- Rain / Thunderstorm likely in Badin, Tharparkar & Umerkot districts today.
- Light rain / drizzle may occur in Karachi division today.
- Guddu Barrage & Sukkur Barrage are experiencing Medium-level flood, while Kotri Barrage is witnessing normal water flow.
