

MONSOON CURRENTS ARE PENETRATING INTO EASTERN PARTS OF

THE PROVINCE

Pakistan Meteorological Department has informed that **Monsoon currents are penetrating** into Eastern parts of the province. Under its influence:

- Rain-wind/thunderstorm is expected at isolated places in Tharparkar, Umerkot, Mirpurkhas, Sanghar, Thatta, Badin districts today.
- Light to moderate Rain/Thunderstorm likely in Kambar Shahdadkot, Dadu, Larkana, Sukkur, Jacobabad & Ghotki districts today.
- Light rain / drizzle may occur in Karachi division today.

Guddu Barrage is experiencing High-level flood, while Sukkur & Kotri Barrage is witnessing Medium and normal water flow respectively.
