Subject: **MONSOON CURRENTS ARE PENETRATING INTO EASTERN PARTS OF THE PROVINCE**

Pakistan Meteorological Department has informed that **Monsoon currents are penetrating** into Eastern parts of the province. Under its influence:

- Rain-wind/thunderstorm is expected at isolated places in Tharparkar, Umerkot, Mirpurkhas, Sanghar, Hyderabad, Thatta, Badin districts today.
- Rain/Thunderstorm with a few light to moderate and isolated heavy falls likely in Kambar Shahdadkot, Dadu, Larkano, Sukkur, Jacobabad, and Ghotki districts today.
- Drizzle / light rain may occur in Karachi division today.

Guddu and Sukkur Barrage is experiencing Medium-level flood, while Kotri Barrage normal water flow.
