Subject: **MONSOON CURRENTS ARE CONTINUOUSLY PENETRATING IN MOST PARTS OF THE PROVINCE**

Pakistan Meteorological Department has informed that monsoon currents are continuously penetrating in most parts of the province.

- Thunderstorm/Rain with a few moderate to isolated heavy falls likely in Jacobabad, Kashmore, Ghotki, Kambar Shahdadkot, Sukkur, Larkano, Tharparkar and Umerkot districts during next three days, while isolated drizzle/light rain may occur in Thatta, Sujawal, Badin, Jamshoro districts and Karachi division.

2. Moreover, Pakistan Meteorological Department has issued warning regarding flash flood (copy enclosed) which is reproduced as under:

Warning: Flash Flooding is expected in hill torrents of DG Khan Division and East Balochistan from 14th to 16th July.

3. Keeping in view of above, it is requested that concerned Deputy Commissioners / Chairman DDMA's and other relevant authorities/ stakeholders may take all necessary mitigation measures.

Note: All concerned authorities are advised to remain "ALERT" and take necessary measures to avoid any untoward situation.

SUBJECT: RIVERS SITUATION AND QUALITATIVE FLOOD FORECAST

I: HYDROLOGICAL SITUATION at 0600 PST AND OUTLOOK

The River Indus is currently in medium flood level at Taunsa, whereas at Guddu, and Sukkur is in low flood, while all other major rivers are flowing within their normal flows.

Warning: Flash flooding is expected in hill torrents of DG Khan Division and east Balochistan from 14th to 16th July. **Urban flooding** is also expected in the metropolitan cities of the Punjab during next three days.

II: METEOROLOGICAL FEATURES

1. Yesterday's trough of westerly wave over north Afghanistan today lies over northeast Afghanistan and adjoining Pakistan.
2. Monsoon currents, originating from the Arabian Sea, are steadily making their way into the central parts of the country. These currents are expected to strengthen further, extending their reach across much of the national territory in the coming days.
3. Yesterday's **MONSOON LOW** over north Madhya Pradesh today lies over east Rajasthan (India). As it advances toward the Arabian Sea, accompanied by a strong influx of moisture, the system is likely to intensify further in the coming days.
4. Seasonal low lies over Northwest Balochistan and its trough northward.
5. Another **Low-pressure** area has developed over west Bengal (India).

III: WEATHER FORECAST FOR 24-HOURS

WARNING: Scattered to widespread thunderstorm/rain with isolated **Heavy falls** and **Torrential rains** at few places is expected over Bahawalpur, Multan, DG Khan, Sahiwal, Lahore, Gujranwala and Faisalabad Divisions. Scattered thunderstorm/rain with isolated **Heavy falls** is expected over the upper catchments of all the major rivers along with Islamabad, east Balochistan, Peshawar, Kohat, Bannu, DI Khan, Rawalpindi and Sargodha Divisions. Isolated thunderstorm/rain is also expected over north Sindh.

IV: WEATHER OUTLOOK FOR NEXT 48-HOURS

WARNING: Widespread thunderstorm/rain with isolated **Heavy falls** and **Torrential rains** at few places is expected over Bahawalpur, Multan, DG Khan, Sahiwal, Lahore, Gujranwala and Faisalabad Divisions. Scattered to **widespread** thunderstorm/rain with isolated **heavy falls** is also expected over the upper catchment of all the major rivers along with Islamabad, east Balochistan, Peshawar, Kohat, Bannu, DI Khan, Rawalpindi and Sargodha Divisions
