Subject: **MONSOON CURRENTS ARE CONTINUOUSLY PENETRATING IN MOST PARTS OF THE PROVINCE**

Pakistan Meteorological Department has informed that monsoon currents are continuously penetrating in most parts of the province. Under its influence:

- Thunderstorm/Rain may occur in Dadu district today.
- While, thunderstorm/rain may occur in Tharparker, Umerkot, Mirpurkhas, Thatta, Sujawal, and Badin districts on 18th July.

2. Moreover, Pakistan Meteorological Department has issued alert regarding flash flood (**copy enclosed**) which is reproduced as under:

Alert: Flash Flooding is expected in hill torrents of DG Khan Division and East Balochistan from 16th (night) to 17th July.

3. Keeping in view of above, it is requested that concerned Deputy Commissioners / Chairman DDMA's and other relevant authorities/ stakeholders may take all necessary mitigation measures.

Note: All concerned authorities are advised to remain "ALERT" and take necessary measures to avoid any untoward situation.

SUBJECT: RIVERS SITUATION AND QUALITATIVE FLOOD FORECAST

I: HYDROLOGICAL SITUATION at 0600 PST AND OUTLOOK

The River Indus is currently in Low flood level at Kalabagh, Guddu and Sukkur, while all other major rivers are flowing within their normal flows. Flows are likely to increase in river Chenab at Marala, Khanki, Qadirabad and river Jhelum at Mangla (upstream) upto medium flood level during next 36-hours. Tributaries of river Kabul, Nullahs of river Chenab and Ravi may attain low to medium flood level.

Alert Flash flooding is expected in hill torrents of DG Khan Division and from 16th (night) to 17th July.

Urban flooding is also expected in the metropolitan cities of the Punjab during next two days.

II: METEOROLOGICAL FEATURES

1. Yesterday's **Well Marked Monsoon Low** over central Rajasthan today lies over Bahawalnagar and is likely to weaken.
2. Yesterday's trough of westerly wave over northeast Afghanistan and adjoining Pakistan continue to persists.
3. Moderate to strong Monsoon currents from the Arabian Sea and Bay of Bengal are penetrating into the upper half of the country.
4. Seasonal low lies over Northwest Balochistan and its trough extends northeastwards.
5. Yesterday's Low-pressure area over east Jharkhand today lies over northwest Jharkhand (India).

III: WEATHER FORECAST FOR 24-HOURS

WARNING: Widespread thunderstorm/rain with isolated **Heavy falls** and **Torrential rains** at few places is expected over Islamabad, Rawalpindi, Gujranwala, Faisalabad, Sahiwal and Sargodha Divisions. Scattered thunderstorm/rain with isolated **Heavy falls** is expected over the upper catchments of all the major rivers along with, Peshawar, Kohat, Bannu, DI Khan, Lahore, Bahawalpur, Multan & DG Khan Divisions.

IV: WEATHER OUTLOOK FOR NEXT 48-HOURS

Wet spell is likely to subside after 36-hours.
