WEAK MONSOON CURRENTS ARE CONTINUOUSLY PENETRATING IN MOST PARTS OF THE PROVINCE

Pakistan Meteorological Department has informed that weak monsoon currents are continuously penetrating in most parts of the province. Under its influence:

- Light rain / drizzle likely in Jamshoro, Hyderabad, Dadu, Tharparker, Badin, Thatta, Sujawal districts, and Karachi division today.
- 2. Moreover, Pakistan Meteorological Department has also issued **Quantitative Flood Forecast of Gauging Stations** (in thousands of cusecs) which is reproduced as under:
