WEAK MONSOON CURRENTS ARE CONTINUOUSLY PENETRATING IN MOST PARTS OF THE PROVINCE

Pakistan Meteorological Department has informed that weak monsoon currents are continuously penetrating in most parts of the province. Under its influence:

- Isolated light rain / drizzle likely in Khairpur, Umerkot, Tharparker, Mirpurkhas, Badin, Thatta, Sujawal, Jamshoro districts and Karachi division.
- 2. Moreover, Pakistan Meteorological Department has also issued **Quantitative Flood Forecast of Gauging Stations** (in thousands of cusecs) which is reproduced as under:
