Pakistan Meteorological Department has informed that Partly cloudy & humid condition are likely to prevail over most parts of the province. However, chances of Drizzle/Light rain are expected in Jamshoro, Thatta, Sujawal, Badin and Tharparker districts during next 24 hours.
