Subject: HOT AND HUMID CONDITIONS ARE LIKELY TO PREVAIL OVER MOST PARTS OF THE PROVINCE.

Pakistan Meteorological Department has informed that:

- Hot and humid condition are likely to prevail over most parts of the province. However, partly cloudy with chances of drizzle / light rain may occur at isolated places in Ghotki, Sukkur, Larkano, Jacobabad, Kashmore, Shikarpur, and Kambar Shahdadkot districts during next 24 hours.
- Partly cloudy with chances of drizzle likely to prevail along the coast and Tharparker district.
- Due to heavy rains in upper parts of the country, Guddu and Sukkur Barrage are experiencing low level flood while normal flow at Kotri Barrage.

2. Moreover, Pakistan Meteorological Department has also issued **Quantitative Flood Forecast of Gauging Stations** (in thousands of cusecs) which is reproduced as under:
