Pakistan Meteorological Department has informed that:

- Hot and humid condition are likely to prevail over most parts of the province.
- Partly cloudy with chances of isolated drizzle likely to prevail along the coast.
- Due to heavy rains in upper parts of the country, Guddu and Sukkur Barrage are experiencing low level flood while normal flow at Kotri Barrage.
- 2. Moreover, Pakistan Meteorological Department has also issued Quantitative Flood Forecast of Gauging Stations (in thousands of cusecs) which is reproduced as under:
