Subject: **PARTLY CLOUDY CONDITION ARE LIKELY TO PREVAIL OVER MOST PARTS OF THE PROVINCE.**

Pakistan Meteorological Department has informed that:

- Partly cloudy condition are likely to prevail over most parts of the province. However, light rain may occur at isolated places in Tharparkar, Umerkot, Sanghar and Jamshoro districts of Sindh during next 24-48 hours.
- Partly cloudy with chances of isolated drizzle likely to occur in Karachi division, Thatta & Badin districts.
- Due to heavy rains in upper parts of the country, Guddu Barrage are experiencing medium level flood and Sukkur Barrage as low level flood, while normal flow at Kotri Barrage.

2. Moreover, Pakistan Meteorological Department has also issued **Quantitative Flood Forecast of Gauging Stations** (in thousands of cusecs) which is reproduced as under:
