Subject: **WARM & HUMID WEATHER IS LIKELY TO PREVAIL OVER CENTRAL &
UPPER PARTS OF THE PROVINCE**

Pakistan Meteorological Department has informed that:

- Warm & humid weather is likely to prevail over central & upper parts of the province. However, partly cloudy with chances of drizzle is likely to be expected at isolated places in Tharparkar, Jamshoro districts and Karachi division during next 24 hours.
- Due to heavy rains in upper parts of the country, Guddu Barrage is experiencing medium level flood and Sukkur Barrage as low level flood, while normal flow at Kotri Barrage.

2. Moreover, Pakistan Meteorological Department has also issued **Quantitative Flood Forecast of Gauging Stations** (in thousands of cusecs) which is reproduced as under:
